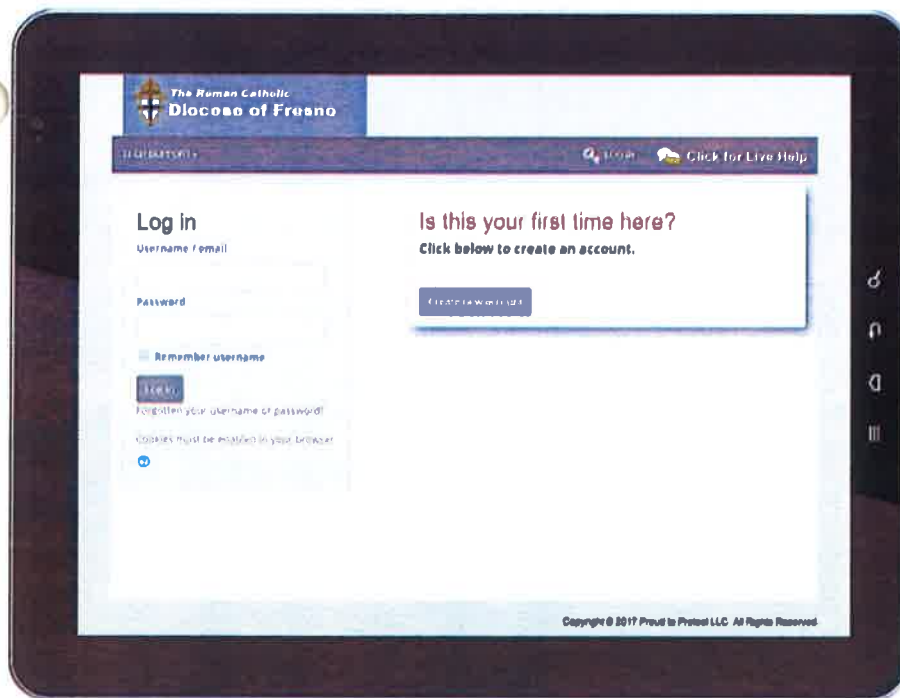

Click the  button to register.


Step 3

You are done with training when you see your certificate on screen.


