TRASH and RECYCLE NOTIFICATION

THE TOWN HAS BEEN NOTIFIED BY OUR PROVIDER THAT RECYCLABLE TRASH CAN NO LONGER BE PLACED IN PLASTIC GARAGE BAGS.

RECYCLABLE TRASH IN PLASTIC GARBAGE BAGS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.

Trash pick-up is on Wednesday. One 90-gallon container (blue lid) will be provided a town resident for household refuse, along with one 90-gallon container (grey lid) for recyclable items. For collection of garbage please place your receptacle out the night before; (Tuesday Night) and **return to the rear of yard** the day of collection (Wednesday). Our provider will be picking up at an unknown time, so it is best to place your trash receptacle out **Tuesday Night**.

YARD DEBRIS

Collection of limbs, cuttings, leaves and grass clippings. Pick up is done weekly. Limbs, cuttings,

leaves and grass clippings should not be mixed together. Leaves and grass clippings should be bagged, limit of **10 (33 gallon) bags not to exceed 40 pounds.**



Limbs and cuttings should be in **one pile (not to exceed 3 ft. in height)** and **MUST NOT EXCEED** a size of **48 inches in length** and **2 inches in diameter**. Piles should be located on **YOUR** property at edge of street. Please

DO NOT place **YOUR** debris on someone else's property. Any piles that **EXCEED** this limit are considered charge piles at a charge of **\$25.00** per load. To avoid this charge, arrangements can be made for personal loading. Please contact the town hall for these arrangements.

UNACCEPTABLE: Loose piles of leaves, clippings, pine straw, any debris resulting from contracted services (including landscapers, laborers and tree services – this debris must be hauled off by the contractors or homeowner), sand or dirt piles.
