

K9 SMART START

For pups under 12 months of age

Guidelines

Promotes handler to "begin" basic training and possibly encourage them to continue to advanced training with future dogs.

Handlers can bait using food or toy.

Pups will wear flat/buckle collar and be on a 6 foot leash. Gentle guidance with leash is acceptable.

Verbal encouragement is acceptable as well as multiple attempts to complete each station/exercise. If after a reasonable amount of time to complete any one station/exercise, the pup is still no longer responding, evaluator has the option to move on to next exercise.

Order of exercise and station is up to evaluator. The stations/exercises are all created with more of a confidence course type of activity for owner/handlers that are new to dog training.

2.	TUNNEL/HOOLA HOOP (can be a child tunnel, the shorter the better. Should accommodate all size dogs. (<i>Demonstrates willingness to go into or under strange objects at handlers request</i>)
1.	PLACE - can be a cot, half crate, box, etc. low to ground, sturdy, accommodating of size and safe. Pup need stay on place only for a few seconds on loose leash. Handler may treat entire time if needed. Pass Needs more work (Demonstrates willingness to climb up on strange objects at handlers request)
