

MGNA Distinction Award - Education/Research/Administration Nomination Form

Eligibility

- The nominee has been an active member of MGNA for the past two years.
- The nominee is an active practising registered nurse, registered psychiatric nurse, or licensed practical nurse.
- A completed nomination form includes signatures of 5 nominators and supporting documentation that addresses how the nominee meets the award criteria.

Criteria

This category is to recognize a nurse who:

- Demonstrates excellence in the specialty of Gerontological nursing and exhibits principles and standards as outlined in the CGNA standards of practice, and,
- Exhibits professional development, role modelling and commitment to Gerontological nursing, and,
- Provides Gerontological nursing education in any setting, and/or,
- Actively engages Gerontological nursing research as a principle or co-principle, and/or,
- Provides nursing management in any setting where the focus of care is the older adult.

Process

The person initiating the nomination will be identified as the primary nominator*. This person may be contacted via telephone if additional information is required. The completed nomination form and documentation are forwarded to the MGNA President-Elect. The award recipient will receive a plaque and will be recognized at the MGNA Annual General Meeting.
