

Kennel Crew / Trainer's Assistant Job Description

This job includes but is not limited to the following tasks.

- Dogs:
- 1.) Assist in the care and well being of the dogs at the kennel.
 - A.) Daily chores- feed, clean, and disinfect.
 - B.) Exercise designated dogs (boarding, finished, overweight, etc.)
 - C.) Observe and watch for any abnormalities.
 - D.) Give baths to dogs going home or as needed
 - 2.) Assist John and Jessie with dogs in training.
 - A.) Run check cord for Intro class.
 - B.) Throw marks (dead birds or DFTs.)
 - C.) Plant blinds or handling pattern.
 - D.) Load dogs into trailer or truck.
- Birds:
- 1.) Assist in the care and well being of the birds (pigeons, ducks, chukars, and pheasants.)
 - A. Daily chores feed and water
 - B. Clean feeders and waterers as needed
 - C. Pick up dead birds
 - D. Predator control (watch for indicators, check live traps, etc.)
 - 2.) Catch birds for training and load into crates
 - 3.) Dead birds in good shape go to freezer
 - 4.) Maintain flight pens and coop as needed
 - 5.) Train Homing pigeons
- Facility:
- 1.) Building Maintenance
 - A.) Monthly bleach and power wash kennel area.
 - B.) Weekly scrub of food pans and likits
 - C.) Additional cleaning as needed (windows, walls, office, bathroom, etc.)
 - D.) Any minor maintenance issues
 - 2.) Grounds
 - A.) Pick up trash
 - B.) Poop patrol
 - C.) Landscaping (planting trees, water new grass and trees, pull and spray weeds, etc.)
 - D.) Mow
- Equipment:
- 1.) Weekly wash of trailers and truck
 - 2.) Care of wingers, remotes, launcher, blank guns, walkie talkies, blinds, etc.
