Helen "Bunnie" Shaw, 95, of Pigeon, died Monday morning, April 10, 2006, at the Huron County Medical Care Facility. She was born December 9, 1910 in Detroit to the late Philip and Emily (Barber) Hutchinson. On April 6, 1929, she was united in marriage to William J. Shaw in Detroit. Bill was originally from the Elkton area, so when he retired in 1966, they returned to Huron County. They lived a short time in Elkton, Caseville, and Bad Axe before settling in Pigeon. He preceded her in death on June 9, 1980 after 51 years of marriage. Bunnie was a past member of the Bay Port Women's Club, enjoyed knitting, playing cards and making handpainted china. Surviving are two children, Bette (Charles) Ulrich, of Bay City, and Bill Shaw Jr., of Pigeon; two grandchildren, Shawna and John; and two great-grandsons, Ian and Alex.
