Purpose:

To provide guidance and outline uniform standards for the Largo Fire Rescue Cadet Program.

Uniforms:

The official uniforms of the unit are as follows:

- a) **Class A** – Grey button down uniform long sleeve shirt (presses) with proper patches attached, cadet badge, collar brass, a black tie, black belt, black dress pants, and black boots that can be polished.
- b) **Class B** – Grey button down uniform dress shirt (pressed) with proper patches attached, a black belt, black or white socks, black dress or BDU style pants, and black boots that can be polished.
- c) **Class C** – A black cadet t-shirt, a black belt, black or white socks, black dress or BDU style pants, and black boots that can be polished.

NOTE: No jeans, sneakers, hats or articles of clothing deemed inappropriate by the cadet advisor or executive board will be worn without permission.

Uniform Standards:

Class A uniforms shall be worn for formal engagements such as City Commission meetings, award ceremonies, funerals.

Class B uniforms shall be worn when attending formal training, special details, restaurants, or visiting fire administration.

Class C uniforms will be the uniform of the day and can be worn for station ride-alongs and informal training.

No single part of the uniform will be worn separately. Members will wear the uniform as a whole or not at all. Uniforms shirts will be issued to the cadet by Largo Fire Rescue.

Membership Responsibility:

All uniforms, including bunker gear, will remain the property of Largo Fire Rescue and will be returned in good repair when leaving the Largo Fire Rescue Cadet program. **CADETS ARE FINANCIALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR UNIFORMS AND TURNOUT GEAR.** All articles supplied by the Largo Fire Rescue Cadet Program are to be returned immediately once separation from the unit occurs or requested by the post advisor. A report will be filed with Largo Police Department if gear is not returned within 30 days.
