Divison A: Quilted Items

- 1. The quilt top and back must be made from 100 % natural fiber fabrics. 50% of the top must be made of wool or wool blend fabrics. The remainder of the top as well as the back must be made of natural fabrics such as linen, cotton, silk, etc.
- 2. Batting is not required; if it is used it should be wool or other natural fiber.
- Any construction or combination of techniques may be used (Machine and or Hand)
- 4. A label must be securely attached to the back with the names of the makers

Categories

- A. Quilt- Minimum size 36" X 42" to maximum 120" x 120"
- B. Wall hanging- Minimum size 18" x 8" to maximum 36" x 42"

Division B: Afghans or Coverlets

- 1. Yarn or fabric must be at least 60% wool blend or specialty wool fibers, including mohair, cashmere, alpaca, camel, vicuna and llama.
- 2. Item may be knitted, crocheted or woven. Felting is acceptable.
- 3. A label must be securely attached to the back with names of the makers.

Divison C: Novelty Items

- 1. Yarn or fabric must be at least 60% wool blend or specialty wool fibers, including mohair, cashmere, alpaca, camel, vicuna and llama.
- 2. Item may be knitted, crocheted or woven. Felting is acceptable.
- 3. Novelty items include, but not limited to slippers, purses, scarves, shawls, hats, mittens, etc.
- 4. A label must be securely attached to the back with names of the makers.
