



#### WANTED: CAPTAIN for 'ONTARIO CARAVAN 2024'



In August of 2024, the National Corvette Museum (NCM) will celebrate the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of its opening! The NCM has grown over the years and currently boasts a representative collection of every Corvette built. Nowhere else will you see the *only surviving 1983 Corvette!*!

To celebrate this special anniversary occasion, Ontario Corvette owners are invited to participate in a Caravan - often referred to as the world's largest moving automotive event - traveling together to the home of the Corvette. Bowling Green, Kentucky is the destination, arriving in time for the museum festivities to begin. <u>The dates are Thursday</u>, <u>August 29 through Saturday</u>, <u>August 31, 2024</u>.

In order to arrive in Bowling Green together, Ontario needs a Caravan Captain to lead us! An event such as this requires planning and coordinating. Will that be you and your team?

The Caravan Captain must be a National Corvette Museum member. If you're not already an NCM member, signing up is easy. Log on to the NCM website at <u>www.corvettemuseum.org</u>, select 'membership' from the dropdown box, select '**Become a Member**' and follow the steps.

Task highlights to be carried out by the Caravan Captain and the ON organizing team are:

- Choose an organizing committee treasurer, co-captain, and others as required (such as regional representatives, ON Caravan shirts, media, sponsorship coordinators)
- o Have the treasurer set up dual signatory bank accounts in both Canadian and US funds.
- Set up a specific ON Caravan email account and ON Caravan Facebook page
- Sign a contract to reserve hotel accommodation in Bowling Green KY for at least 50 rooms. Request complementary accommodation for the ON Captain in return for the large number of rooms being booked.
- Organize the route from ON to Bowling Green, deciding where best to cross the border. (Note: Unless the captain is familiar with the choice of routes from Ontario to Bowling Green, it is helpful to drive the route and take note of the possible overnight stops along the way.)
- Sign a contract to reserve hotels for the overnight stops on the route to Bowling Green. Request complementary rooms for the ON Captain in return for the large number of rooms being booked.
- Compose and manage the ON webpage for the NCM website including local contact data, ON registration sheet with payment method and amount (~\$25/car) and submit to NCM for posting. Send updates to the Museum as necessary.
- o Post the above information on the ON Caravan Facebook page. Update as required.
- Attend twice-yearly 'Caravan Captains' meetings at the NCM if able, or send an alternate to represent the ON Caravan team.
- Participate in NCM Caravan fund-raising efforts by purchasing items for re-sale to ON Corvette drivers - window clings, flags etc.
- Choose a convenient departure point from ON which has parking and washrooms for all ON Caravan participants
- o Other tasks to be completed or delegated as / when required.

# 2019 Corvette ZR1 proves Its still King against the 2023 Z06



Justin from <u>Horsepower Obsessed</u> drove his Black 2019 Corvette ZR1 over to <u>StreetSpeed 717s</u> place to check out the new C8 Z06 with the straight pipe exhaust. Once again, the new exhaust note is just unbelievably loud as we see Justin doing the cold start on the Z06 from StreetSpeed's garage. You can barely hear the ZR1's own start-up from the cockpit with that Z06 rumbling next to it.

The two YouTubers do several highway pulls against each other. Justin was getting some tire slip, but once he got the ZR1 dialed in, the Kings' greater horsepower overcame the Z06's weight bias on the rear wheel tires to take the winner more times than not. That's not to say the Z06 was spanked. Far from it, anytime that Justin lagged on the start, the Z06 got out in front and would nearly stay there.
















## **C8 Stingray Lines Up the Competition, Knocks 'Em Down at the Drag Strip**



Drag Racing and Car Stuff brings us a nocturnal video showing a Stingray take on gasoline and electric-powered challengers and emerges as the victor in all three races.

First up is a Jaguar F-Type that falls behind early and can't ever catch up, finishing with a time of 11.96 seconds and 118 mph top speed, well behind the C8's 11.44 seconds and 120 mph.

Next comes a McLaren, which again can't match the start of the Corvette but manages to narrow the gap before ultimately losing to the upstart and much lower-priced Chevy. The Corvette manages a time of 11.734 seconds and 120.34 mph to edge the McLaren's 11.739 seconds and 130.54 mph.

Finally comes the fully electric Tesla Model 3. The Corvette again takes an early lead that holds up all the way to the finish line, with the Stingray managing an 11.389-second, 120.33 mph run to handle the Tesla's 11.638-second, 115.38 mph effort.
