OLD BUSINESS

Pickford Ambulance – Leslie received a recent bill for service from Pickford Township. She has reached out to confirm the billing dates and to set up a future discussion to finalize billing terms for the next four years.

NEW BUSINESS

Dock Use – The township board has received complaints regarding overnight parking at the south Raber dock. Residents shared concerns over dock spaces being used overnight for an extended period of time. Residents also raised concerns that the township is receiving monies to allow overnight docking. The township board clarified that a donation was received to be used towards dock work. The board agreed that the donation would be distributed into the Recreation Fund and earmarked for future dock improvements.

Paul will reach out to the owner of the vessel to inform them that there is no overnight parking permitted. A resident also shared that there could be room for parking expansion to improve the flow of traffic.
