ALL DAY SUMMER RIDING CAMP 2017

Wake Robin Farm takes great pride in creating a memorable equine experience for all of its campers. Each day offers new surprises as campers learn about horsemanship, stable management and equine sports. Themed camp days allow campers to explore a variety of riding disciplines including English equitation, cross country, western, mounted games, musical rides and more. Hands on horsemanship sessions introduce campers to horse care, feeding, grooming and first aid. Campers tap into their creative side with fun + unique horsey crafts and partner up for exciting team building challenges and activities around the farm.

Camp hours run from 9am - 4pm each day.
Extended hours are available from 8:30am -4:30pm for an additional fee.

What To Expect

- **Each camp day is divided into 7 one-hour segments:**
 - Formal Riding Lesson Horsemanship
 - Stable Management
 - Small Animal Care (foster kittens, mini's, chickens, goats etc.)
 - Lunch + Supervised Free Time
 - Creative Horsey Crafts
 - Outdoor Games + Activities
 - Fun Themed Afternoon Ride
- **Wake Robin Farm provides all day fresh snacks for its campers.**
- **Of course summer riding camp wouldn't be complete without a Friday Show Day!**
Campers spend the morning polishing and prepping their horses for the afternoon horse show. Parents are invited to come out and watch their campers demonstrate their riding skills. Horse show starts at 3pm sharp!

Wake Robin Farm camp sessions are structured to accommodate riders of all levels. Campers ride twice each day. All riders will be taught, with emphasis on sound basics of safety, equitation and good horsemanship. For the intermediate/advanced rider, we offer a more extensive program which allows riders to continue developing their riding skills in order to meet higher goals. Campers work in a safe and friendly environment with supervision at all times.

All Campers must wear proper riding equipment and dress appropriately for the weather. Helmets, boots and long pants are mandatory while riding. Boots must cover the ankle and have a small flat heel (1" high). Helmets can be rented for an additional fee. Shorts and running shoes are allowed for non-horse activities. Campers should bring their own lunch and a refillable water bottle.

Please remember that Wake Robin Farm is a NUT-FREE facility.
