



The following rules of engagement apply to all NSW South Coast HOG members engaging in the chapter's social media presence, including Facebook, Website and Team App.

Any posts, comments, chats etc that fall in one of the following definitions will be deleted, and the member will receive a warning.

The following are not allowed -

1. Profanity (Swearing)

There will be no excessive use of profanity.

2. Trolling (incitement of members)

Trolling will not be tolerated in any way.

Definition - In Internet slang, a **troll** is a person who sows discord on the Internet by starting quarrels or upsetting people, by posting inflammatory, extraneous, or off-topic messages in an online community (such as a newsgroup, forum, chat room, or blog) with the intent of provoking readers into an emotional response or of otherwise disrupting normal, on-topic discussion, often for the troll's amusement.

3. Personal Discrimination

There will be no racial, ethnic, or gender-based insults or any other forms of personal discrimination.

4. Offensive or inflammatory posts

There will be no posts meant to offend or hurt any other member, in a manner which is offensive or inflammatory.

5. Pornography

Pornographic content (or links) are not allowed.
