## 1 SHENANDOAH VALLEY / CHAMBERSBURG, PA

We board our deluxe motorcoach to begin our tour to Cape Cod. We travel through East Tennessee before entering the "Old Dominion State" of Virginia. Our lunch stop is Salem, Virginia. We will continue through the beautiful Shenandoah Valley arriving in Chambersburg, Pennsylvania for the night. **L**

## 2 & 3 NEWPORT, RHODE ISLAND

After breakfast this morning, we skirt New York State and travel through Connecticut enroute to the Newport, Rhode Island area for a two night stay. We enjoy a guided tour of this unique city including the colonial section and one of Newport's beautiful mansions. The Breakers, the most famous mansion in Newport, was built for Cornelius Vanderbilt. We will follow scenic Ocean Drive back into downtown Newport with lunch and time for shopping and browsing in the afternoon. Also in the afternoon, we will enjoy a one hour narrated cruise of Historic Newport Harbor and Narragansett Bay! Dinner included one evening. **D**

## 4 SANDWICH, MASSACHUSETTS / LUNCH DANIEL WEBSTER INN / TOUR SANDWICH AND HYANNIS

We depart Newport this morning traveling to Sandwich, Massachusetts. Sandwich is the oldest town on Cape Cod and one of the oldest towns in the United States. We will visit the Sandwich Glass Museum, internationally renowned for the display of beautiful glass made in Sandwich during the 19th and 20th centuries. Daily glassblowing demonstrations, a multi-media theater, a contemporary glass gallery, new seasonal exhibits, special Museum exhibits and a dazzling Gift Shop, are what you will find at the "best glass gallery on Cape Cod"! A delicious grand buffet luncheon is included at the Daniel Webster Inn. After lunch we will have a guided tour of Sandwich and Hyannis with a photo stop at the JFK Memorial. We spend four nights in Hyannis. **L**

## 5 MARTHA'S VINEYARD AND OAK BLUFFS

Today we meet our local guide at the Steamship Authority at Woods Hole for an exciting day on the little island of Martha's Vineyard. We will visit three down island towns..... Edgartown, Oak Bluffs and Vineyard Haven. You will have an exclusive guided walking tour of the unique Gothic Gingerbread Cottages in Oak Bluffs, with plenty of time for shopping in Edgartown with lunch (included). We will also visit the three up island towns of West Tisbury, Chilmark and the Indian town



of Aquinah (Gay Head) with interesting cliffs, a working lighthouse and Indian shops. There will be time for shopping before returning to Woods Hole and to Hyannis. **L**

## 6 ISLAND OF NANTUCKET

This morning our local guide will meet us at the hotel and take us for an all-day tour of the Island of Nantucket. A brief boat ride takes us to the Island. Much of Nantucket's charm is associated with its cobblestoned main street, small lanes, plain Quaker-style homes and handsome houses that date from the whaling days of the early 19th-century. After a tour of the island, you will have the rest of the afternoon free for shopping and browsing on this unique island. The Paddock Restaurant in Hyannis, today considered a Cape Cod institution, opened its doors in 1970 making and maintaining a name for itself as "a tradition", "a classic" and a "must do" on Cape Cod. We will enjoy a delicious dinner (included) this evening. **D**



## 7 PROVINCETOWN / DUNES TOUR

This morning our local guide will take us along historical Route 6A (Old Kings Highway) to the north side of Cape Cod on our way to Provincetown—"land's end". We will make a stop at the Cape Cod National Seashore Visitor's Center, and a drive past Nauset Lighthouse and the Cape Cod National Seashore. In Provincetown, we enjoy an included lunch at Napi's in the center of town with time to shop and browse in the downtown area. Before departing Provincetown, we enjoy a dunes tour. Imagine dunes stretching as far as you can see. You will travel through the majestic dunes where your guide points out the "dune shacks" where famous artists and writers like Eugene O'Neill and Harry Kemp became inspired to create their art. We will enjoy a lobster dinner this evening. We return to Hyannis for the night. **D**

## 8 CHAMBERSBURG, PENNSYLVANIA

We depart Hyannis this morning and retrace our route through Connecticut, New York, New Jersey and Pennsylvania for our last overnight at Chambersburg.
