The children love to get involved in the running of Grange and raise money for those who need it most. Here are some of the things that they do:

- Run the Tuck Shop in the middle and upper unit daily (they apply for this position)
- Apply to be part of the media team – they create and sell CDs to parents after concerts/residential week and weekends
- Run their own workshops (Year 6) for the younger children
- Reading mentors asked to run own reading competition – they sourced prizes, bid for money and submitted receipts to office
- Work with the school librarian to choose books for the library using money from Book sales
- Raise money through creating Christmas cards and knitting Easter chicks
- Raise money through selling anti-bullying wristbands
- Create their own competitions and quizzes for children/parents
- Invite parents in to look at their work and sometimes sell it to them!
- Create shoeboxes at Christmas for Africa
- Work alongside Deputy Head to decide what to sell for Remembrance day and worked on their own to create a wreath for our local cenotaph
- Run own stalls at Summer/Christmas Fayre to raise money for the school
- Children have sent letters to the SLT to request support for charities close to their heart – this has resulted in “Jeans for Genes” day and selling cakes/toys stall during break time for Cancer Research
- Choir sings at local supermarket – all proceeds go to Charity
