The MUA increased appropriations \$169,148 (6.2%) above the 2013 operating budget. The projected rate of \$12.08/1,000 gallons represents a 5.0% increase in sewer charges to system users for 2014.

A minimal rate increase will be necessary to maintain the authority's solvency.
