DESCRIPTION: Bud Hitt was a popular bowyer in the 1960's and 70's. He made high-end target and hunting recurves such as the Black Ace, Supreme, Shooting Star, and Huntsman. The Huntsman was billed as the world's first weighted handle section hunting bow that stabilized the bow and reduced torque. This RARE Hit Huntsman has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in very good condition. The upper tip overlay was missing (no damage to the tip or glass), so I tried to duplicate the tip overlay. You can see the differences on page 6). No dings or cracks. There was a chip on the end of the outer arrow shelf on the back side. This was filled with epoxy putty and stained (see right pic on page 5). No crazing or stress cracks; A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in fair condition. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.
