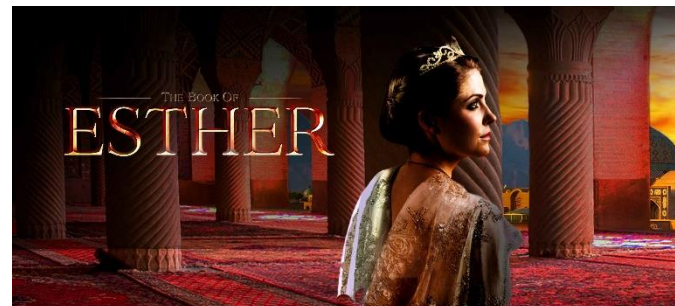
Sr High Sunday School has been moved to Rm #7-East door in the basement for today.
