

New Policies and Procedures for MiniMovement Academy: (Creative Movement and Mini Movement Classes)

1. All dancers must have a signed Release of Liability form on file (attached) before they may enter the building. This document can be printed, signed and returned with your dancer on the first day back, or you can scan it and email it back to us (preferable) before your first day back. If you already turned one in, you do not need to complete a new one.
2. Prior to coming to the studio, please conduct a health assessment of your dancer and your family. Any dancer exhibiting any sort of fever or symptoms of COVID-19 personally, or who has had any contact with anyone exhibiting any symptoms, should not come to the studio.
3. Please arrive in the parking lot no more than 10 minutes prior to class, and try not to be late, as we have staggered class times to maintain physical distancing in the lobby between classes.
4. Dancer and parent should remain in their vehicles until just before your class time. Please enter one at a time, maintaining physical distance from others.
5. Only registered students and TDH faculty will be permitted in the building at this time, **as well as ONE parent per Mini Movement Academy dancer**. Dancer and parent only will enter through our main entrance (Door 1), with the guidance of our faculty. Classes have been assigned exit doors and will be directed by our faculty at all times. Class times and exit door information is included in your class email.
6. Again, ONE parent/guardian will be allowed to enter our building during their child's class. This parent/guardian will be required to wear a face mask for the entire time they are in our building. Please note all lobby chairs have been removed from our lobby. Markings for physical distancing during observation must be adhered to. Siblings or other guests will not be permitted in our building at this time. Please refrain from exiting/re-entering during the class time.
7. Creative Movement 1 dancers will not be permitted to attend class without a masked parent. Physical markings have been made within the studio classroom for ONE parent for each of these dancers. Updated policy: Parents of Creative Movement 2 dancers have the option of having 1 parent/guardian attend class with their dancer.
8. Dancers are only permitted to bring in their dance bag w/shoes (MiniMovement 1, 1/2, 2). No water bottles, please.

9. Dress Code will be required and enforced. Dancers should wear only their dance attire.
10. Dancers MUST have their hair neatly and secured off the neck and away from the face prior to coming into the studio (this is very important to keep students from touching face during class). Absolutely no jewelry is permitted. Other items such as headbands, etc. should not be worn as they also often lead to touching of the head/face and are distracting.
11. All TDH faculty will be wearing face coverings. Dancers will not be required to wear a mask as we will be marking the floors, barres, and lobby transition areas to maintain physical distancing.
12. The water station will be available but should be used for emergency purposes only. The vending machine will remain unavailable at this time.
13. Both bathrooms will be opened for individual student use, and sanitized frequently during classes. We encourage dancers to try to use the restroom at home, prior to coming to class, however.
