


From the West

Take PA Turnpike to Exit 57 (Monroeville.) After tollbooth take far right exit ramp towards Murrysville. Follow Route 22 East through Murrysville to intersection with Route 66 (10.4 miles.) Take Route 66 North ramp to Delmont.

***From the intersection of Rt. 22 and Rt. 66:

Continue north on Route 66 (2.9 miles) through two traffic lights past the Schwan trucks on the left. Just after you pass the Delmont Veterinary Hospital on the left, turn RIGHT into driveway for the Delmont North Industrial Park. Continue to the buildings at the top of the hill.

From the South or East

Take the PA Turnpike or Interstate 70 to the New Stanton interchange. Follow PA Toll Road 66 North to intersection with Route 22 (13.8 miles). Pass under Route 22 and follow directions from ***above.

From the North


Take Route 66 South. From the Route 380 intersection, continue 7 miles South past the blue Volkswagon sign. Turn left into Delmont North Industrial Park. Continue to the buildings at the top of the hill.

Entries close at 6 PM on Wednesday, September 11, 2024, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. When the Rally trial reaches 100 entries or when maximum 8 hour / judge time limit is met, a wait list will be maintained until the closing date. **Please indicate if yours is a UDX, RAE or RACH entry on your form if you do not wish to be entered in fewer classes.**

Make All Checks and Money Orders payable to the Westmoreland County Obedience Training Club (**WCOTC**). Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. **Please use black or blue ink on all checks.**

Telegraph, Telephone, and Unsigned Entries Cannot be Accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms, or photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. This is a new style AKC entry form - ****SIGN YOUR ENTRY ON THE BACK****
Note that there are separate entry forms for Obedience & Rally.

Entries without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as possible after trial closes. If a legible email address is provided, judging program and confirmation of entry will be emailed. Paper copies will only be mailed by request. Should acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary at Calnik@aol.com or 412-310-5564.

Transfer/Move-up Policy: Obedience & Rally transfers to another class will be accepted as space permits within entry limits, in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations. Requests for transfer must be made in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of each trial. Forms may be downloaded from the AKC website at www.akc.org or requested from the Trial Secretary.

Postdated Checks and Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. WCOTC will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries; however, if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Declination of Entries. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Westmoreland County Obedience Training Club may decline any entries and may remove any dog because of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim against WCOTC or any official thereof.

Entry Fees Shall Not be Refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entries will be made.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in the filling out of entry forms. Corrections cannot be made after the closing date. Please be certain that you fill in the right class and have the correct jump height on your entries. No entry and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors, or for cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print carefully on entry forms to eliminate errors.

Bitches in Season will not be admitted to the Trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season on the Trial date will be refunded the entry fee less \$5.00 (each day) upon written certification by a veterinarian given to the Trial Secretary before the start of judging each day.

Exhibitors are Responsible for the Behavior of Their Dogs and/or Children.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when they are called to be judged. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused.

TEAM Obedience will be offered on Saturday: **Team Obedience**

A team will consist of 4 handlers and dogs performing the Novice exercises in a drill team manner as described in the Obedience Regulations with these exceptions.

During the Drop On Recall exercise, the first handler will leave their dog on the judge's order, call and drop the dog when judge signals. When the first dog is down, the next handler will leave their dog, call and drop the dog when judge signals. Each dog will remain in place until all 4 dogs are called and dropped, at which time the judge will command or signal for all handlers to call their dogs. Handlers may use BOTH hand signal and a verbal command to drop the dog.

The group stay exercise will consist of all teams sitting their dogs and walking around the group in the direction the judge indicates. When the handlers return to the front of their dogs, they will remain there until the judge orders them to return. Teams of dog will be placed in a row, with multiple teams being placed back to back with the other teams.

Entry Fee is \$20/Team (or \$5/dog)
