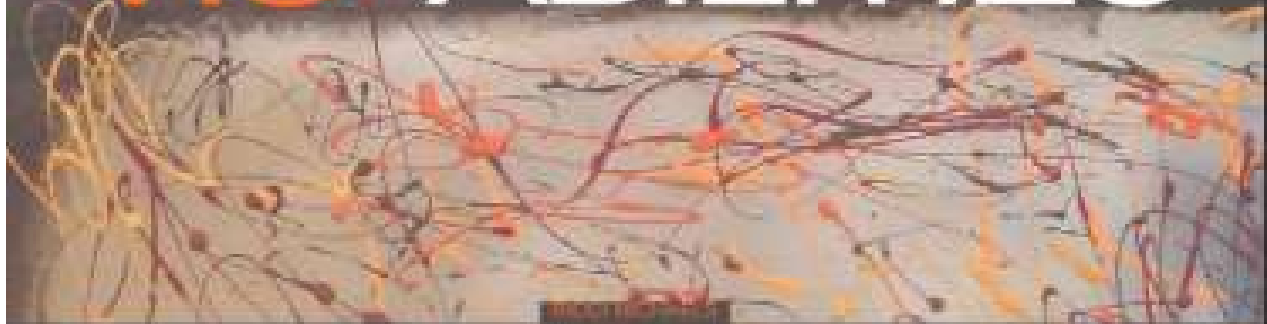


VIS•ABILITIES
