



**CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL
MEETING AGENDA**


1. Call to order and quorum call. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tanguma at 6:32 p.m. at Sandy Oaks City Hall. Present for the meeting were Aldermen Thomas Repino, Anthony Garcia, Charles Fillinger, and David Tremblay. Also, in attendance were City Attorney Cassandra Ortiz and City Clerk Katherine Yelton. Alderman Tomasini was absent due to a death in his family.
2. Pledge of Allegiance. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Tanguma.
3. Discuss and/or possible action on an Ordinance amending the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year Budget for municipal purposes, to account for less carry over funds and appropriate funds for the City Marshal total expenses and Public Works total expenses. Mayor Tanguma stated the carryover at the time she created the budget was \$637,434.00. As of the date of the meeting, the bank balance was \$497,454.20; therefore, she wanted to adjust for the new carryover. Alderman Tremblay made a motion to distribute the \$75,000 Animal Control total equally between the three line items of Animal Control Officer, Equipment and Supplies, and Animal Control Officer-Other. Seconded by Alderman Repino and passed unanimously. Alderman Fillinger made a motion to subtract \$30,000 from City Marshal Salary & Benefits' \$120,000, leaving a balance of \$90,000 and a Total City Marshal balance of \$245,000, remove all \$25,000 from Animal Control-Other, leaving the Total Animal Control balance at \$50,000, remove all \$20,000 from City Administrator leaving \$105,000 in Total Contract Expenses, subtract \$25,000 from Public Works Employees \$90,000, leaving \$65,000 and a balance of \$231,000 in Total Public Works and adjust the Net Income to the new total of \$1,798. He also made a motion to adopt the ordinance amending the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year Budget. This was seconded by Alderman Tremblay and passed unanimously.
4. Adjourn. Alderman Fillinger made a motion to adjourn at 7:02 p.m., which was seconded by Alderman Garcia and passed unanimously.
