We also had a guest speaker, Richard Herrington, who discussed insurance coverage. Our master policy has a \$10,000 deductible now and 5 million in liability coverage. The increased deductible was to discourage small claims. Richard also discussed individual policy coverage. The recommendations were: Loss assessment coverage of at least \$50k, liability of 500k, additions and alterations of at least 10k, and enough personal property insurance to cover the contents of your entire home.

Maintenance Items

Since winter is quickly approaching, please remember to remove statues, hoses and lawn decorations from your yards. It is also a good time to replace the batteries in smoke alarms and test them to be sure they are working correctly. Another safety tip is to make sure the oil fill pipe is kept clear of any snow.
