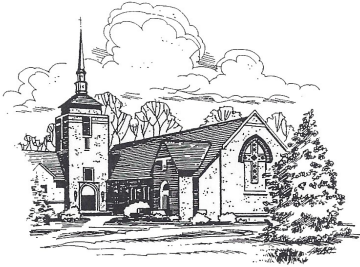

Helpers are needed! Please sign-up at the back of the Sanctuary, if you can help!!

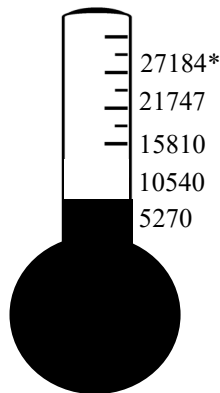
We will be assembling lunches at 9:00am in the Kitchen—followed by distribution at 11:00am at the Corner Table Soup Kitchen.

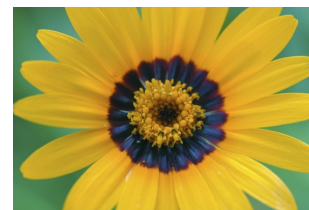
