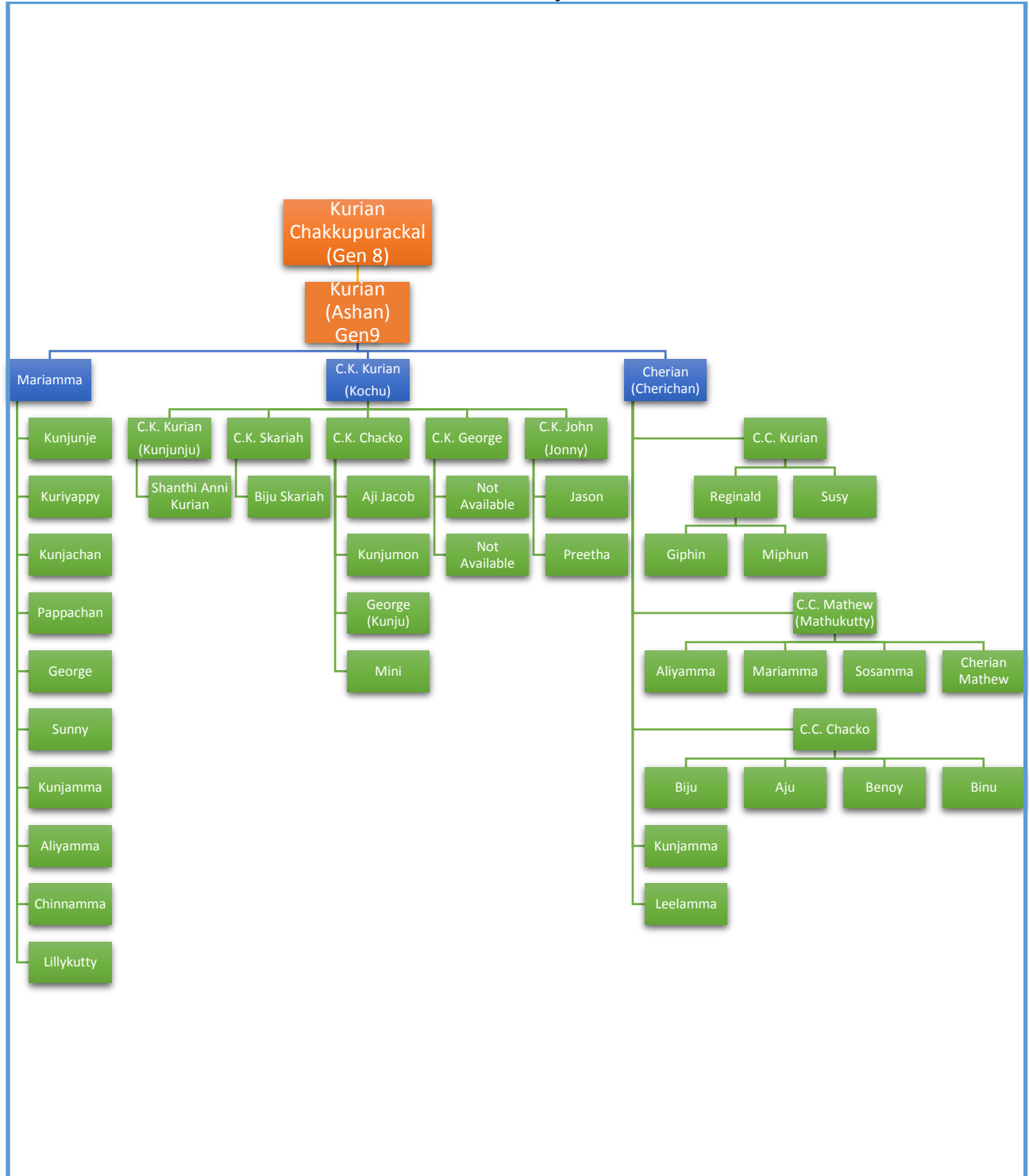
CHACKUPURACKAL FAMILY HISTORY

Chackupurackal Family History

Our forefather Plathottam Joseph who moved from Champakulam to Mammoottil had a son – Kurian. Kurian had two sons – the elder son was Kurian and the younger was Mathen. The elder son Kurian, after his marriage moved to the Puthupparambil property which he had acquired earlier. The younger son Mathen continued to live in Mammoottil home.

Kurian who moved to Puthupparambil had two sons – Kurian, Chacko and daughter Aliyamma. The elder son Kurian lived in Puthupparambil at Vellukutta, and the younger son Chacko moved to Poothakkuzhy at Thalappady. Chacko had two sons – Kurian (Pappy) and Uthup (Kutty). They are the fathers of Chirappurath and Poothakkuzhy families.

Kurian who lived in Puthupparambil had three sons – Kurian, Chacko, Varghese and a daughter. The elder son Kurian moved to Chackupurackal at Thalappady. The second son Chacko moved to Chorikkavil at Thalappady. The younger son Varghese continued to live in Puthupparambil home at Vellukutta.

Kurian Chackupurackal

Kurian who moved to Chackupurackal had only one son – Kurian. He was later known as Chackupurackal Ashan. During his early age, his father Kurian died. He grew up with his mother's protection and care.

Kurian (Ashan)

After his education, he was much interested in spiritual matters. He provided leadership and administration for the growth of the Nazareth Mar Thoma church at Thalappady during the beginning stage of the church. He was married to Mariamma, Thadathil family at Kochumattam. They have a daughter – Mariamma and two sons – Kurian (Kochu), and Cherian (Cheriachan). Daughter Mariamma was married to Homeopathic Doctor Joseph (Kochu), Parappallichirayil family at Vadavathoor. They have six sons – Kunjunju, Kuriyappy, Kunjachan, Pappachan, George, Sunny and four daughters – Kunjamma, Aliyamma, Chinnamma, and Lillykutty. Kurian's (Ashan) wife Mariamma died during her middle age. Ashan was one of those fathers in the community who donated necessary land for the building of the school associated with the Nazareth Mar Thoma church at Thalappady. He had served as a teacher and as the manager of the school. He was a leader and the key individual to build the Nazareth Mar Thoma church at Vellukutta, and the church leadership appointed him for the spiritual leadership and to conduct burial services during the absence of Priests. On 1949 Ashan went to be with the Lord. His body was buried in the Jehovah's Witness church cemetery at Vellukutta.

Kurian (Kochu) – Elder Son of Kurian (Ashan)

Kurian was born on 1908. After basic education he married Chinnamma - daughter of Cherian, Kochupurackal family at Thalappady on 1927. They have five sons – Kurian (Kunjunju), Skariah, Chacko, George and Jonny. On 1950 Kurian (Kochu) sold his portion of the Chackupurackal property to his brother Cherian. He purchased a house and property at south Vazhakulam, Aluva and settled there with his family. After his children finished their education and started working, the house they were living at Vazhakulam was not convenient, so he sold that and purchased a house and property in Aluva Town near the Bank Road and settled there.

Kurian (Kunjunju) – Elder Son of Kurian (Kochu)

Kurian was born on 1929. On 1949 he passed E.S.L.C. and started working in Southern Railway. During his work he acquired B.A.B.L. from a private college. Afterwards, he worked for a company at Hyderabad. During this time he married Lillykutty, Earalil family at Paravur. Later they moved to England, and then moved to Chicago in USA. While working in Chicago he completed CPA and started working in University of Chicago. His wife Lillykutty is working as a Nursing Supervisor in Chicago. On 1992 Kurian retired from his work. He died on 1993. His body was buried in the Mar Thoma church cemetery at Chicago. They adopted a daughter – Shanthi. Shanthi is studying for M.B.B.S in K.M.C Medical College at Mangalore. Lillykutty is settled in Chicago.

Skariah – Second Son of Kurian (Kochu)

Skariah was born on 1933. After S.S.LC education he started working in Andhra Pradesh. He married Mariamma from Vazhakulam at Aluva. They have a son – Biju Skariah. Skariah died on 1985. His body was buried in Jacobite church at south Vazhakulam, Aluva. His son Biju Skariah completed his degree got a job and moved to Bombay.

Chacko –Third Son of Kurian (Kochu)

Chacko was born on 1936. After basic education, he continued to live with his parents. Later he married Mariamma – daughter of Kunjappan, Kallupalathinkal family at Manarcad. They currently live in Aluva. They have three sons – Aji Jacob, Kunjumon, Kunju (George) and a daughter – Mini. Aji and Kunjumon are working in Police department. Younger son Kunju (George) continues his education. Daughter Mini is married and she lives in Kalady.

George – Fourth Son of Kurian (Kochu)

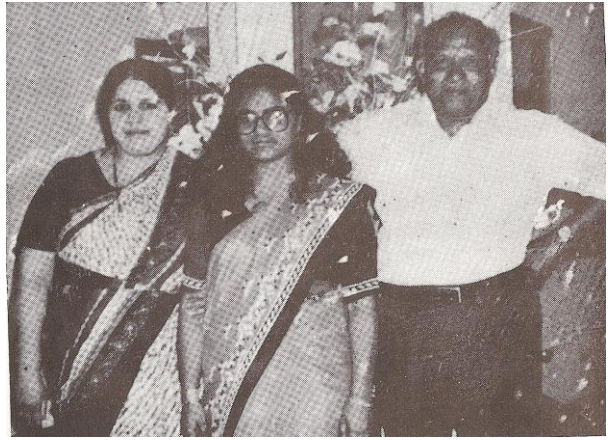

Jonny – Younger Son of Kurian (Kochu)

Jonny was born on 1955. After high school education, he moved to Chicago, USA. On 1979 he came back and married Leelamma, Kochupurackal family at Kottayam. They have a son – Jason and a daughter Preetha. Jonny and family are settled in Chicago, USA.

Cherian – Second Son of Chackupurackal Kurian (Ashan)

Cherian was born on 1912. After basic education he was involved in business with his father. In 1935 he married Sosamma – daughter of Kochikka, Illickal family at Vellukutta. They have three sons – Kurian, Mathukkutty, Chackochan and two daughters – Kunjamma and Leelamma. On 1951 Cherian sold Chackupurackal property at Thalappady and purchased a property and house at south Vazhakulam near his brother Kochu's house and settled there. He was involved in agriculture at this place. Later in 1962, he sold that property and home and moved to Puthukkulam near Lakkattoor.

Kunjamma – Elder Daughter of Cheriachan

Kunjamma was married to Skariachan, Vadakkekara family at Vellukutta. They have two sons.

Leelamma – Second Daughter of Cheriachan

Leelamma was married and was doing ministry work in Madras with her husband Cherian. Her husband went to be with the Lord on 1984 and Leelamma went to be with the Lord on November 25, 1980. Their bodies were buried in Jehovah's Witnesses church cemetery at Vellukutta.

Kurian – Elder Son of Cheriachan

Kurian was born on 1936. After basic education he became an evangelist. Later he married Thankamma – granddaughter of Kochacko at Anathanam. They have a son – Reginald and a daughter – Susy. They purchased a land and house at Sankaracherry, Manarcad, and currently live there. Both Kurian and son Reginald are running an agency "Weighing Balance Company". Susy is married to Kuriakose, Ambalathungal family at Uzhavoor. Reginald is married to Eetha – daughter of Mathew at Vandanmedu. They are living with their parents in Chackupurackal home at Sankarachery.

Mathukkutty – Second Son of Cheriachan

Mathukkutty was born on 1940. After obtaining high school education, he got involved in agriculture. On 1964 he married Thankamma, Kuttanpara family at Kooroppada. He wanted to advance in agriculture; therefore he purchased more land and a home at Vandanmedu and continued agricultural work in a much larger scale. They have three daughters – Aliyamma, Mariamma, Sosamma and a son – Manoj (Cherian Mathew). Aliyamma is married to a family at Chellarkovil. Second daughter Mariamma is married to Mon, Mangatt family at Manarcad on June, 1997.

Chacko – Younger Son of Cheriachan

Chacko was born on 1944. After basic education, he married a girl from Thazhathedath family at Anakkara. They have four sons – Biju, Aju, Benoy and Binu. They are currently living in Puthukkuam and are involved in agriculture.
