The assessor will start the revaluation of the township on July 15. The School District of West Salem needs the approval from the Town of Washington for a Crossing Guard Ordinance. They will be sending out a sample ordinance. We will review next month.

Tom and Sue Meyers presented to the board their variance requests that they have made to La Crosse County Zoning to build a garage. A motion was made and seconded to support the variance requests for Tom and Sue Meyers. The motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the picnic and gathering permit for The Bohemian Valley Sportsman club on June 16, 2019. The motion carried.

We discussed heating options for the town hall and will get estimates for putting in an LP heating unit. Estimates will be reviewed next month.

We reviewed the miscellaneous correspondence. We received the Hazardous Waste Report from the county. Our next meeting will be Wednesday, July 10, 2019 at 6 pm. A motion was made and seconded to adjourn the meeting. The meeting was adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
