

## Here's how the EWQHA Prize Ride works:

Purchase your tickets at registration (\$5 each ticket) that you will use to enter to win the 5 big main prizes. Purchases as many tickets as you like for additional chances to win. These 5 main big prizes are known as the "Big 5". These range in value from \$200-\$400 each. You then keep one half of your ticket stub and place the other half in your choice of the Big 5 prize cans, also referred to as buckets. For example: I have purchased 7 tickets that I purchased for \$35. I tear them apart and keep one half of the dual stub for myself as proof of winning number, and decide I want to:

Place 2 tickets in the Gibson and Son Excavation bucket to win gravel/shale.

I then place 1 ticket in the Don Bacon leather bucket to win the beautiful handmade bosal.

I then decide I want to place 1 ticket in the Luft trailer bucket to win a propane fire pit and \$200 worth of service.

Of course I need hay for my critters, so I put a ticket in the Calaway premium Timothy hay bucket

1 ticket goes in the bucket for the bundle of #9 compressed hay.

The last ticket I have will go into the special bucket we designate for the 4-H and Scholarship fund. It is an extra bonus prize that is really great!

You have the option to place your tickets in buckets at Base Camp or you can deposit your ticket along the route at the check point that represents the Big 5 prize you wish to win. Buckets from trail station check points will be combined with the Base camp buckets prior to drawing for the prize.

After all Big 5 prizes have been won, you STILL have additional chances to win as all tickets from the Big 5 buckets will be combined in a tub and tickets will be drawn until all remaining smaller prizes have been given away.

Don't forget – there is also a 50/50 raffle. These tickets are a different color and only cost \$1 each. The idea is we total the amount of \$1 tickets sold and split the pot between the winner and the club. Hence 50% to the winner/ 50% to the club – 50/50 raffle. Last year the winner walked away with nearly \$500 for a \$1 investment. Not bad!

The main thing is to have fun, enjoy the ride and know that you are supporting some wonderful equine education and learning for the community.

# RULES of the RIDE



Just a few rules and courtesies we ask of YOU, our valued rider:

1. No Firearms.
2. No smoking on trail.
3. No dogs on trail or at registration.
4. No stallions.
5. Pack out your garbage or leave it at one of the checkpoints.
6. Do NOT remove trail flagging ribbons along the trail.
7. Riding on the grassy airfield is PROHIBITED. Stay on gravel road around the airfield. This is an active air strip.
8. Enjoy your trail ride and let others also enjoy. Be courteous.
