

# Broda Sportsplex COVID-19 Facility Plan

The Broda Sportsplex COVID-19 Plan has been created with health and safety a top priority. You can do your part in keeping sports and recreation available at the Broda Sportsplex this winter season by following the safety protocol that has been put in place. Individual arena users, user groups, visitors, and renters found not following these rules may be asked to leave the facility and risk future access.

**Disclaimer:** *The Town of Kamsack is not responsible for any fines incurred by arena users or spectators for not following the Saskatchewan Re-Open Plan/Public Health Orders as well as the Return to Play guidelines provided by the user group's governing body or provincial sport organization.*

## The Broda Sportsplex is dedicated to providing a safe and clean facility through:

- Following and implementing provincial guidelines, recommendations, and restrictions for operating a recreation facility.
- Disinfecting all high contact surfaces and touch points after each user group.
- Promoting physical distancing, cough etiquette and hand hygiene.



## General COVID-19 Protocol

- **Stay home** if you are showing signs of infection or illness consistent of COVID-19.
- The second floor, including the Mezzanine and bar, will remain closed at this time.
- The **concession and vending machines** will be closed.
- Bring a **full water bottle** as water stations are unavailable.
- Practice **physical distancing** and **hand hygiene**.
- Follow all posted signage and protocols.
- **Mask up before entering the facility.** Masks are required at all times within the facility and on the ice surface.
- Follow direction of traffic and distancing markers.
- Do not share personal equipment with others.
- No outside food permitted.
- **Hand Sanitizer** available upon entry and throughout the facility.
- The **maximum number of participants or spectators** in any one area must be followed at all times.
- Gathering or congregating in the lobbies is prohibited.
- Complete COVID-19 screen questions prior to entering the building.
- A record of **all arena users**, for contacting tracing purposes, will be kept for no less than 1 month.
- Designated **quarantine/sick room** for those with symptoms or signs of illness while at the facility. Parent or Guardian will be contacted immediately for pick up.
- There are **no "in and out"** privileges once in the facility.

## Public Skating COVID-19 Protocol

- A **one time registration** form is required. If under 18 years of age it is to be filled out by a parent/guardian. Registration form **MUST** be completed and given to arena staff prior to using the facility.
- **Mask up** before entering the facility. Masks are required at all times within the facility and on the ice surface.
- **Be dressed**, with the exception of skates prior to entering the facility. Participants will have access to the lobby.
- Arrive no more than 10 minutes before your activity
- Leave promptly within 10 minutes of completing your activity.
- Maximum of **8 patrons** on the ice surface at one time.
- **Shinny and informal games are NOT allowed.** Users may make shots on the net during stick and puck if they maintain 3 metres of physical distancing at all times.
- Upon entry users must **check in** with arena staff for contact tracing purposes. **Arena staff will monitor** all activities during public skating time.
- Participants are to **maintain 3 metres** from each other while in the facility and on the ice surface.
- Guardians/Caregivers are mandatory for the supervision of those under the age of 12 to a maximum of **8 in the bleachers** with physical distancing of 3 metres and mask use.

## Private Rentals (Skating Rink) COVID-19 Protocol

- **Masks are required at all times** within the facility. Masks must be worn on the ice under the helmet.
- **Maximum of 8 participants on the ice surface during a session.** This does not include coaches/trainers.
- All Saskatchewan Hockey Association Members must follow all guidelines and regulations released by the Saskatchewan Hockey Association.
- Bring a **full water bottle** as water stations are unavailable.
- Any **shared team equipment** should be disinfected between individuals.
- The renter is responsible for the actions of their group.
- Skill development and instruction training are allowed with **3 metres of physical distancing** at all times.
- The renter must have a designated “**Safety Person**” for the scheduled ice time who is responsible for the following:
  - Screening and contact tracing for all participants, officials, coaches, trainers and spectators upon arrival. (Please provide a copy of attendance to the Recreation Director)
  - Ensuring guidelines and protocols are followed.
- Coaches must maintain 3 metres of physical distancing and wear masks.
- Gathering or congregating in the lobbies is prohibited.



### Practices:

- Arrive no more than **10 minutes before** your practice and leave promptly within **10 minutes after**.
- **Be dressed**, with the exception of skates, prior to entering the facility.
- **Each participant may have one guest** for a total of **8 spectators in the fixed seating bleachers**.
- Dressing rooms will not be available. Lobby will be set up for tying skates.
