



Sneak Peek—April Meeting Project

Catch a Falling Star By Barb Jones

DecoArt Paints:

Uniform Blue Deep Burgundy

Tangelo Espresso
Tomato Red Lamp Black

Brushes:

#2 Flat, #10 Flat, Fine Liner or Script Liner, 3/4" Flat for base coating

Other Supplies:

Rust-Oleum Texture Spray Paint (optional if you want texture) Cord or Ribbon for Ornament White Graphite Regular Painting Supplies

Prep before meeting:

Base coat with Uniform Blue (over texture paint if used)
Sand lightly if needed
Transfer Pattern
Base coat Snowman with Buttermilk

I will have a pattern at the March meeting.

Please basecoat the chickens before class, if you have time. If not, plan on working on just one or two chickens.

After base coating surface black, stencil chicken wire on the entire surface with Marigold. Trace your pattern and base coat as follows:

Lettering: Whispering Turquoise

Chickens from Left to Right—Mulberry, Wasabi, Coral Blush, Whispering Turquoise, and Purple wave.

Combs and waddles—Country Red

Feet and beaks—Marigold

Broccoli Cranberry Salad—From Sharlene

Ingredients

- 6 strips bacon, cooked & crumbled
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 1/4 cup white sugar
- 2 tablespoons red wine vinegar
- 3 heads broccoli, finely chopped
- 1/2 cup chopped red onion
- 1/3 cup sunflower kernels
- 1/4 cup dried cranberries

Directions

- 1. whisk mayonnaise, vinegar, and sugar in a bowl; refrigerate until ready to combine with salad.
- 2. Combine broccoli, onion, bacon, sunflower seeds, and cranberries in a large bowl. Drizzle mayonnaise dressing over broccoli mixture; toss to coat.
- 3. Refrigerate 1 hour.

Surface and supplies:

Door Crown - 16 ½" x 6 ¼" Or surface of choice - Round plate, bread board, tea pot

Sealer

Chicken Wire Stencil – for background

Opt: small check stencil and polka dot stencil (various sizes of polka dots)

Deco Art Americana Paints: (If you don't have all these colors, we can share or substitute what you have and colors you like.)

Black Sreen Napa Red Peaches and Cream

Black Plum Prussian Blue

Burnt Sienna Purple Cow

Coral Blush Purple Wave

Country Red Soft Blue

Dioxazine Purple Traditional Raw Sienna

Evergreen Vivid Violet

Grape Juice Wasabi

Green Tea Wedgewood Blue

Light Buttermilk Whispering Turquoise

Marigold Opt.


Moon Yellow Neon blue Glamour Dust

Mulberry Neon Pink Glamour Dust

Prep:

Sand and seal surface. Paint black. Stencil chicken wire on entire surface in Marigold. Trace pattern on surface.
