Administrative Expenses

\$56,108.00

Expenses include printing, postage, HOA common area insurance, cost of letters sent to homeowners for collection of HOA dues and deed restriction violation, etc.

Contract Services

\$68,262.00

Expenses include landscape contract to maintain entrances, common area and park; MASC Austin Properties, Inc. management, patrol services, storage for all the Association's documentation and community event supplies, etc.

Maintenance

\$7,450.00

Expenses include repairs to park area, entrance signs, irrigation repairs, tree trimming, community events, flags displayed at entrances, etc.

Utilities

Expenses included streetlight electricity, entrance monument lighting and irrigation water usage.

Don't Forget To Download The Fort Bend County App

<u>Fort Bend County Information Technology</u> has partnered with PublicStuff to create a mobile app to better interface with residents and allow individuals to clearly and directly communicate specific problems within the County. *Connect with Fort Bend* provides another option for residents to submit, track and view nearby non-emergency service requests through their smartphones and <u>online</u>. By simply snapping a picture, damaged or downed street signs, potholes, drainage problems and similar issues can be reported and routed to the appropriate County department.



Once requests are submitted, the relevant staff redirects and responds to requests through a customized workflow management system. Residents can also use the in-app widgets to find information about events, public facilities and polling locations, as well as receive alerts of emergencies and County activities. In a time when most people live in the world of apps, citizens will be able to quickly reach out to County staff about a particular problem or issue they might have. *Connect with Fort Bend* will transform the relationship with residents through technology. The app is available for download from Apple and Google.

Together We Can Make A Difference

Crime Stoppers is a program that empowers regular people to fight back against crime. Anyone can *submit* an anonymous tip by using our Online Web Tips, Mobile Tips, or by calling the Tip Line. If that tip leads to an arrest, you can receive a cash reward!

In Texas, a person, including a law enforcement officer, may commit a crime if the person intentionally or knowingly divulges the identity of a Crime Stoppers Tipster. Crime Stoppers needs the information you have regarding crimes and criminals, NOT your name! To further ensure a tipster's identity is never known, CRIME STOPPERS PAYS REWARDS ONLY FOR ANONYMOUS TIPS! Tipsters who identify themselves are not eligible.

Overgrown Trees In Tara Are Still A BIG Issue



Overgrown trees are still a big issue in Tara Association. We would like to again remind all the homeowners that have overgrown trees on their property the importance of having their trees trimmed.

Visibility of the stop signs and the delivery trucks, school busses and emergency vehicles are becoming a very serious issue at this time. All trees and limbs growing in or near a right of way must be trimmed to the regulated height of 12 feet above streets and 8 feet

above sidewalks. Inspection signs will be placed around the neighborhood on September 1st to remind all homeowners that a tree height inspection will be done starting October 1st.

Please inspect your trees and have them trimmed to help out with this situation and avoid further enforcement

Deed Restrictions For Our Community

Some of the most common deed restriction violations in Tara Association:

- Lawns need to be mowed, edged and grass needs to be removed from expansion joints.
- Fences need to be repaired or replaced.
- Mildew needs to be removed from exterior of home.
- Misc. items such as trash cans, coolers, BBQ pit, toys, etc. need to be stored properly and out of public view.

If you are making any type of improvement to the exterior of your home, you must submit a Home Improvement request form to MASC Austin Properties, Inc. before starting the work. This includes painting the exterior, fence replacement, room addition, driveway extension, etc. You can find the form on our website www.mascapi.com under "MY NEIGHBORHOOD"- Tara Association; on the left hand side of the page "ACC APPLICATION FORM". Please send it in with the necessary information and samples for a quicker response.
