The award will be mailed directly to the school of the awardee's choice, upon receipt of verification of acceptance and enrollment to a college or university.

- Continuing College Student Scholarship (\$1,000): Scholarship will be awarded to a continuing college student currently enrolled in a college or university. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative college grade point average of 3.00 (on a 4.00 scale) or higher.

Applications must be emailed or mailed and postmarked no later than **Wednesday, March 31, 2021** to the address on the application. Scholarship award recipients will be notified by May 1, 2021.


Students must be United States citizens and current high school seniors attending a Stafford or Fauquier County high school. Scholarship awards can only be used for the 2021-2022 academic year. Students may apply for the following scholarships at <http://www.staffordaka.com/scholarships.html>.

- **Service Leadership Scholarship (\$1500):** Scholarship awarded to high school student(s) possessing demonstrated innovative initiative-driven leadership in or out of school impacting him/her academically and/or have done extraordinary work to strengthen their community. This work may deal with social issues, civic issues, address health or environmental concerns, or promote arts and humanities. Must have a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher.
- **"ThinkHBCU" Scholarship (\$1500):** Scholarship awarded to high school student(s) with a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher and who will attend a Historically Black College or University (HBCU) and has demonstrated leadership abilities through participation in community service, extracurricular, or other activities.
- **Arts Scholarship (\$500):** Scholarship is awarded to a high school senior who has declared a major in the Arts. Student must have a minimum 2.5 out of 4.0 GPA and be pursuing a major and a career in the Arts.
- **Vocational/Community College Scholarship (\$500):** Scholarship awarded to a high school or continuing college student(s) who will attend or is currently enrolled in a vocational school, trade school, or community college in the United States.

Applications must be emailed or mailed and postmarked no later than **Wednesday, March 31, 2021** to the address on the application. Scholarship award recipients will be notified by May 1, 2021.
