Carson James Horsemanship Clinic Information

- If <u>OUT OF STATE</u>, please make sure to bring your coggins and health certificates for the horse/s you are bringing in.
- > Dogs must be on leash and under control at all times.
- > Absolutely no unsupervised young children allowed without parent or guardian.
- > All participants must be at least 16 years of age...NO Exceptions.
- > Boots with a heel are required for riding.
- > <u>ALL participants and auditors</u> must have a signed liability waiver on file.
- > Please have your hay pre-bagged for feeding if tied at trailer, no loose hay.
- > Participants must have completed and submitted all information & waiver sheets
- Check in is between 7:45-8:15AM just outside the covered arena gate for all riders. You must check in to receive your wristband to ride.
- > If bringing friends/spouses to audit, they will also need to check in to receive their auditing wristband.

> Please bring a rope halter with a long lead and flag for ground work, , your feed, water bucket, & tack

- > Complimentary donuts will be available in the morning.
- Clinic starts at 8:30am and will go until around 5pm each day.
- The first part of the morning will be ground work. You have the option to saddle or just arrive with halter, lead and flag. There will be a short break after the groundwork portion to saddle if need be.
- > We will take about a 1 hour lunch break. Lunches will be brought in each day. Pizza one day and subs the next.
- > Please pick up any garbage, loose hay, and manure in the parking area prior to leaving the facility.
