RULES & REGULATIONS

***** **CALL BEFORE YOU HAUL** *****

These Dress Code Rules/Regulations are required by Lake Charles Livestock Show & Rodeo. All participants are required to abide by the dress code, in order to participate in the trail ride. Anyone not in compliance will be asked to change their attire or they will not be permitted to continue until they are in dress code. **ANY RIDER/PARTICIPANT** not in dress code will reflect on the ENTIRE RIDE.

WESTERN ATTIRE REQUIRED – These requirements apply to **ALL** participants, whether you are a horse/mule, rider and /or wagon rider (**male & female – ALL AGES**)!!!! Shirts must be traditional full collared Western Shirts & authentic pioneer style (preacher) short collar shirts. **NO** t-shirts, sweatshirts, sweaters, halter-tops, knit style modern western shirts, shirts with no collars (JUDGING POINTS ARE DEDUCTED FOR SHIRTS (MALE & FEMALE) NOT BUTTONED/TUCKED IN)

- Jeans must be solid in color – **NO** designer jeans, overalls, sweat pants or shorts
- Western boots– **MUST** have a defined heel; **NO** chukka, tennis shoes, or hiking boots
- **All men & boys MUST** wear felt/straw western cowboy hats; we would really appreciate women & girls wearing them also. **NO** baseball caps, visors or stocking/knit caps-in extreme cold weather ear muffs are permitted, but not the knit caps
- Rain Gear must be riding slickers (2 piece rain suits or ponchos); **All** must be solid in color, **NO CAMOUFLAGE**
- All clothing (shirts, coats/jackets)**CANNOT** display any commercial advertising or camouflage
- Once the ride has arrived in camp, each evening, you **do not** have to be in dress code compliance

ANYTHING WITH COMMERCIAL ADVERTISING (this includes shirts, jackets, etc.) IS NOT PERMITTED, remember, we are promoting Western Heritage.

****Due to safety/liability purposes, nobody will be allowed to join the ride once we have pulled out in the morning. You may not join the ride until lunch AND ALL the proper paperwork has been completed – there will not be any exceptions! ****

HORSE & MULE REQUIREMENTS

- All Equine must have current Negative Coggins & Health Certificate. One (1) legible copy of each must be given to the Trail Ride Secretary to keep on file. NO COGGINGS, NO HEALTH CERTIFICATE, NO RIDE, NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- All Mules/Horses must be pulling or riding. Keep up, no lagging behind.
- Any Mule/Horse appearing sick or in poor condition will not be allowed.

HORSE RIDER & WAGON REQUIREMENTS

- Rubber Tire Wagons/Buggies allowed.
- **NO** Commercial Advertising of any kind displayed on any Wagon or Buggy.
- Trail Ride Badge must be displayed on chest area of outer garment at all times. **NO** trading or sharing of badges. Your badge is numbered and the badge **you** are wearing must match **your** signed liability release.
- **NO** Double Riding.
- **NO** Public Display of Alcohol, all alcoholic beverages must be in a koozie or in an unidentifiable plastic container (including wine bottles).
- **PLEASE, NO GLASS** containers during the ride – this also applies to wagon riders.
- **NO** glass containers are permitted on public roads. Please see the front wagon or scout/officer, if you need a koozie.
- **NO** Alcohol during the Parade.
- **NO** riding on sidewalks or anywhere off the road.
- **ALL** Riders must stay on the street behind the wagons.
- **Please** leave your campsites clean, no large piles of hay or trash should be left.
- **NO** open campfires, all campfires must be contained in a metal container.
- **PLEASE HELP** by cleaning your area!!!
