The conference was well attended by HAPT members as well as a broad cross-section of individuals from the Department of Education, various community agencies and those in private practice settings.

Others who have assisted HAPT deserve our thanks as well. *Roger Epstein*, husband of member *Barbara Kirk* and attorney with Cades, Shuttle, Flemming and Wright, has been working closely with Monica Evans in revising our bylaws. They have aligned the bylaws to be consistent with those of APT and to be legally sound. The board has reviewed the first draft of the bylaws and made its suggestions. When all revisions have been completed the board will bring the bylaws to the membership for review and vote for adoption. *Joni Orimoto*, of the Price, Waterhouse, Coopers accounting firm, continues to work with Carla Sharp regarding our 501(c)3 tax status. We appreciate these individuals and their pro bono work on behalf of HAPT.

This has been a year of working to organize, update and move forward. We started the year by creating a database for our various mailing lists. We completed close to 700 entries for the DOE and local mental health agencies. The database will help us to streamline the process of mailing HAPT workshop and conference information. There is more to be done to complete the data bases, such as creating one of past HAPT conference participants, and a data base of HAPT members whose memberships have lapsed. We are also working on obtaining our bulk mail permit. Bulk mail will be a cost-effective way of distributing our workshop and conference materials.

Carla Sharp busily entered our financial information this year and our financial information from the past two years on Quicken. From now on, the treasurer's job will be much easier. Quicken will allow our treasurer, to make financial reports and tax information readily available, as well as the ability to create charts and graphs of our financial standing.

We are in the process of drafting a procedural handbook for the board's, committees' and/or member use. This will provide a means for passing along important information from year to year as the board and committee membership changes. The HAPT board has updated and edited the HAPT five-year plan. A copy of the plan will be available at our October 4, 2003 Annual Meeting and Workshop. Our major goal next year will be to locate HAPT office space, to establish a central location to house all our files and a common meeting place for board and committee meetings. HAPT will continue to support the mission of the organization by offering training in play therapy and by providing support to increase the number of members who become Registered Play Therapists (RPT). Our two member workshops each year, which are free to HAPT members, and our annual conference help to meet these goals. Occasionally we cosponsor activities with Sandplay Therapists of Hawaii. Perhaps in the future we can expand training opportunities by cosponsoring workshops/conferences with other play therapy related groups.

Next year we will cease to offer group supervision since it was not as well attended as we had hoped. The money previously used for supervision will be reallocated in the 2003 - 2004 HAPT

budget towards obtaining HAPT office space.

Please consider getting more involved in your HAPT, volunteer and participate in any way you can! HAPT is seeking new board members, committee members for our conference 2004, co-chairs for our Conference 2005, program committee co-chairs, and a membership committee. HAPT board meetings are usually held the second Saturday of each month from 1:00 to 4:00 p.m. Members are always welcome to attend the board meetings. Please contact a board member for the location of a meeting you may be interested in attending, as our meeting place can change month-to-month. Contact the HAPT board with questions and suggestions, and let us know how we can become more responsive to your play therapy needs.

Please remember to vote for your new board members. Ballots will be mailed to you the second week of September and are due by September 27, 2003. Results of the election will be announced at the October 4th HAPT Annual Meeting and Workshop.

Nomination forms have been mailed to fill four (4) positions on the HAPT Board of Directors for the 2003 - 2004 term. The following positions are open:

<u>President-Elect</u>: 3-year commitment; 1st year as president-elect, 2nd year as president, and 3rd year as past president. The president-elect presides over all meetings in absence of the president; keeps a record of all members; sends out notices of meetings; becomes president

in case of death or resignation of president; assumes duties of the president on 1st Saturday of October every year.

<u>Secretary:</u> 1 year commitment. Keeps a full and accurate record of the proceedings of all meetings; makes minutes available to members; keeps a copy of the notices for all meetings; assists the president-elect; maintains a historical record of the activities of the association.

<u>Treasurer:</u> 1 year commitment. Maintains accurate and correct books and accounts for the association; prepares a financial report as well as an annual financial statement; makes deposits disburses funds in the name of the association.

<u>Member-at-Large</u>: 1 year commitment. Serves as a liaison between the Board of Directors and the members through the publication of a quarterly newsletter, and responds to all applications for membership.
