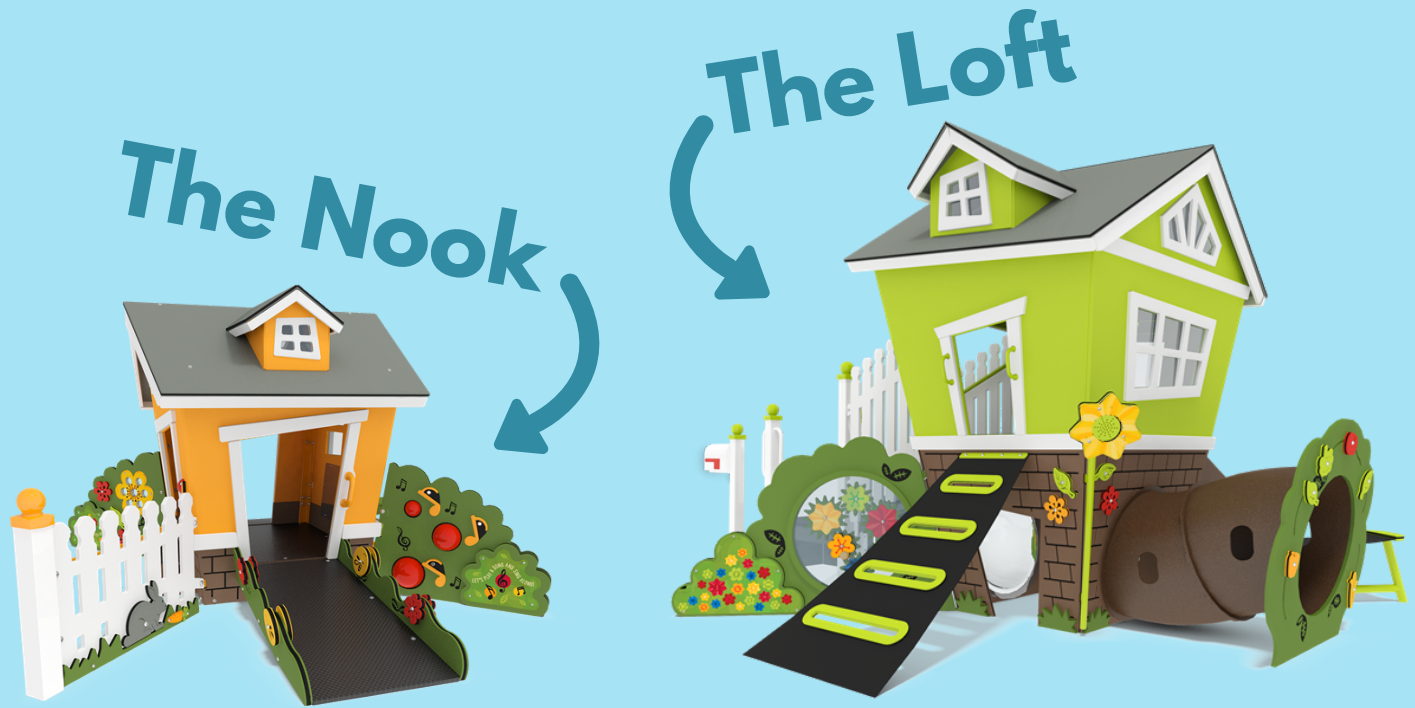


Lebanon Plays



The Nook

The Loft

In 2014, the Upper Valley Lake Sunapee Regional Planning Commission conducted surveys for Lebanon's Safe Routes to Play project where they learned that many of the playgrounds in the City lack structures that are safe for young children such as low climbing structures or bucket swings. As a result, the City of Lebanon and Upper Valley Lake Sunapee Regional Planning Commission, with the help of the Healthy New Hampshire Foundation, teamed up to gather residents in support of improving playgrounds for children under 5 in the City.

Lebanon Plays is a group of volunteer residents focused on creating developmentally-appropriate playgrounds for children under the age of five across Lebanon. Lebanon Plays chose to improve the play space in Colburn Park as our first project (with more to come!). We've spent the past year and a half meeting with city officials and landscape companies to discuss our options. After extensive research, we have decided that the Loft (for ages 2 - 5) and the Nook (for ages 6 mos - 2 yrs) are the perfect addition to Colburn Park.

Lebanon Plays is working with the city's Recreation and Parks Department, along with the Friends of Lebanon Recreation and Parks, to raise the funds required for the playground. The total cost of the project is \$37,800. As of the first of August, we have raised \$6,500 from grants and donations. We need your financial support so that the playground can be built in May 2018.
