

from your Vice President

As the WALPN Vice President I was appointed by JoAnn Shaw, WALPN President to the Wisconsin Center for Nursing Board of Directors LPN seat on December 31, 2021. I have served in the LPN seat since January 1, 2022 on the WCN Board of Directors. At the end of 2022 I was nominated to continue serving in this capacity which I graciously accepted.

In October of 2022, I attended the NALPN Annual Conference in San Destin, Florida with JoAnn Shaw (WALPN President) and Debbie Blanik (WALPN Director), which was a successful annual conference that included a Mental Health First Aid Certification. On November 6, 2022, I had been elected by the National Association of Licensed Practical Nurses Board to serve on the NALPN Board of Directors 2022/23 in the position of a Director on the Board, as well as be the Co-Chair for New State Chapters under JoAnn Shaw, the NALPN Vice President and Chair for New State Chapters. Thus far, I have followed up with emails to four new states who have contacted NALPN to start a new state chapter since November.

As the WALPN Vice President I sent out emails to instructors of 46 colleges that have Practical Nursing Programs and then also followed up with phone calls to each of the instructors at the 46 colleges as well as handing out annual conference information to other LPN's that I have been working with at LTC facilities in Northern Wisconsin. I also stopped at Scrubs Boutique and More in Wausau, WI, handed the employee working there our conference information and explained our annual conference to her. I asked if the scrub shop would be interested in being a vendor at the annual conference. The employee there was interested and excited about this opportunity for the shop but stated that she had to give the information to her supervisors who will make the decision. if they want to be a vendor. I did a follow up call with this scrub shop employee today who again sounded very interested but stated that she had not heard back from her supervisor regarding being a vendor at the annual conference. I am optimistic that we will have a great annual WALPN Conference this spring.

WALPN joining with Wisconsin Health Care Association

Wisconsin Association of Licensed Practical Nurses (WALPN) continues to strive for quality education, quality standards of care, and quality protection of the patient. To further this mission, we were happy to join the Wisconsin Health Care Association (WHCA) in their grant application to the US Department of Labor to create WisCaregiver Careers CNA to LPN, a scholarship program to help CNAs working in long-term care advance their careers.

WHCA is a trade group which represents long-term care providers in Wisconsin. They are a non-profit which has administered the state's free CNA training program, WisCaregiver Careers, since 2020. The grant application seeks to expand WisCaregiver Careers to the LPN level for the first time.

WALPN is participating in the grant as the recognized, professional voice of LPNs, to offer guidance in objectives and how they fit into the LPN everyday life. You, our valued members, are the ones who walk the walk and are the experts in all facets of health care, job roles, challenges, and more.

If approved, the grant would provide 115 full-ride Practical Nursing Diploma scholarships which include tuition, books, and fees. The training is spread across four college semesters to help the CNAs fit the training into their work schedules. The program design also features a Supportive Services Fund that the trainees can apply to for help paying reasonable and necessary expenses associated with their education, such a childcare and transportation.

WHCA submitted their grant application on January 19, 2023 and expects the grant award decisions will be made public sometime in February 2023. At our April 2023 conference we are proud to have Kate Battiato, Vice President of Workforce Development at WHCA to be a speaker! Mark your calendar to attend! She is the program administrator of WisCaregiver Careers and the glue that is coordinating the grant process and excellent communication with the partners.


