## **Greetings Everyone!**

One of the highlights for our family this summer was watching our baby Hannah take her first steps. All summer, while we were on vacation, we'd see her try to stand against things to build that confidence in her legs. She had quickly learned to crawl fast and seemed

to prefer it. Imagine all the walking we did on vacation and having to carry her all the way!

So, of course, as soon as we returned home from our trips, she decided to take her first steps all by herself. That was about six weeks ago, and now she cannot stop! She runs and runs, spins in circles, climbs onto the couch, and has even learned to open some doors!

And six weeks ago, she crawled on the ground.

Walking is an image we find throughout the Bible. It can be metaphorical or even literal. We think of our "with" God as a journey. We are moving in a direction, heading towards something in our relationship with God.

Walking also allows us to see a change.

When we walk somewhere, we end

up in a different place than we were before. In terms of our

relationship with God, it is a sign of progress, learning, maturity, and growth.

Watching a baby crawl, you can see their brains at work. Sure, she is moving and getting somewhere, but she also sees others moving while standing up on two legs. They are moving faster. Though it looks complicated, the

results are apparent. Walking looks a lot better than crawling.
