Secretary's Report: On file in the secretary's book. One correction was made: The antique snowmobile registration is \$20 for the first three years and \$5 for every three years after.

AWSC Director's Report: The Assembly and Senate both passed the cleanup bill, and it will go to the Governor on the 10th. The DNR is trying to get the word out about the new trail pass and has sent out emails. The AWSC will spend up to \$10,000 to help get the word out. ISMA offers a grant to help with this type of promotion. All registered snowmobiles got an explanation both last year and this year with their registration stickers. AWSC membership is up.

Trail Report: Levi passed out road crossing maps and needs them back ASAP. Last month landowner lists were handed out and he needs these back with any changes noted ASAP, along with new leases. Milton has all of their trail in. All clubs should get their trail put-in hours to Levi as soon as they are finished so he can turn in a bill. There is still a lot of corn in the fields because the weather is not cooperating.

President's Report: All clubs need to get their new members involved with club activities. Make them feel welcome and part of the club.

Groomer Report: Donnie will get working on the drag for the tractor. Some disking needs to be done by Orfordville.

Youth Advisor Report: Lynsey Burzinski is excited to be our new youth rep. She will attend a Director's meeting in January, and there is a youth ride in February.

Old Business: We will table the discussion on Chapter 3 bylaws.

New Business: Trail open/close policy will remain the same as last year. Levi will contact each club for conditions and give the information to the County for the phone line. He will also send an email to the Alliance list and Erica will put it on Facebook.
