Meeting Adjourned at 10:30 a.m.


News from our dubhouse Chair:

Summer Wildflowers

Summer's here and Michigan's native wildflowers are sprinkling our landscapes with color. You can see wildflowers right here at Colonial Acres, as well as wooded areas in local parks, and even along the roadsides.

The trillium that blanketed our woods by the clubhouse has faded, but you may still see mayapples in those woods. Another woodland plant like trillium, mayapples typically grow in colonies derived from a single root. And if you peek under a mayapple in the spring, you might find a flower hiding under its wide leaves. Mayapples and trillium love shade and thrive in a woodland habitat. We are fortunate to have such a special habitat right here by the clubhouse.

By the way, there are nine species of trillium native to Michigan, half of which are considered endangered or protected. And all the parts of the mayapple, except the fruit, contain podophyllotoxin, which is highly toxic if consumed. Podophyllotoxin is used in some prescription drugs used to treat certain cancers, psoriasis and other illnesses. Who knew?

Did you know that dwarf lake iris is our state wildflower? It's an endangered flower that grows along shorelines. I haven't seen any here, but we do have yellow flag iris near the bridge by the pond, which add a pop of color to the landscape.

You've probably seen day lilies along ditches or in parks. And pale blue Chicory plants can be found almost everywhere, if you know what to look for. Queen Anne's lace, crowned with tiny creamy white flowers, is pretty easy to spot. If you see some purple blossoms, it might be wild bergamot. It's helpful to have a wildflower guidebook to help identify wildflowers when you are outdoors. I consider myself an amateur on identification without a guide.

One of my pet peeves is when I see children or adults walking along a trail in a park with a handful of freshly picked wildflowers. Seems like this doesn't happen as much as it used to, but it's important to remember that saying "take only photos, leave only footprints." Let our wild areas stay wild.






