RESTORATION UPDATE Our Bishop has approved the feasibility of this project on May 28, 2019. The Diocesan Property Committee recommends that we obtain two more estimates in addition to the one quote for \$450,576.20 including HST, that we already have from Mr. Carlos Nunes.

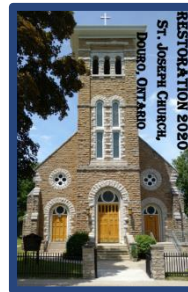
We have now received two more quotes.

One from Roof Tile Management for \$699,259.00 plus HST.

Another from Clifford Restoration Ltd. for \$3,631,200.00 plus HST.

Mr. Carlos Nunes will do a very thorough interior restoration of the church.

RTM is not a thorough restoration group. They are only do repair work where needed. They will not do restoration. Their quote is also much higher than Mr. Nunes. The Diocese has approved to go with Mr. Nunes. At a later date Mr. Nunes will come to the parish and meet with the people and explain more about the restoration.

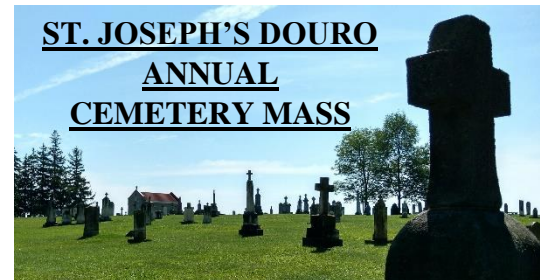

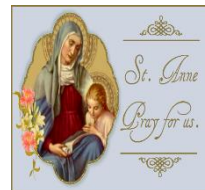
FRENCH BOYS' CHOIR TO SING AT SACRED HEART, PETERBOROUGH
