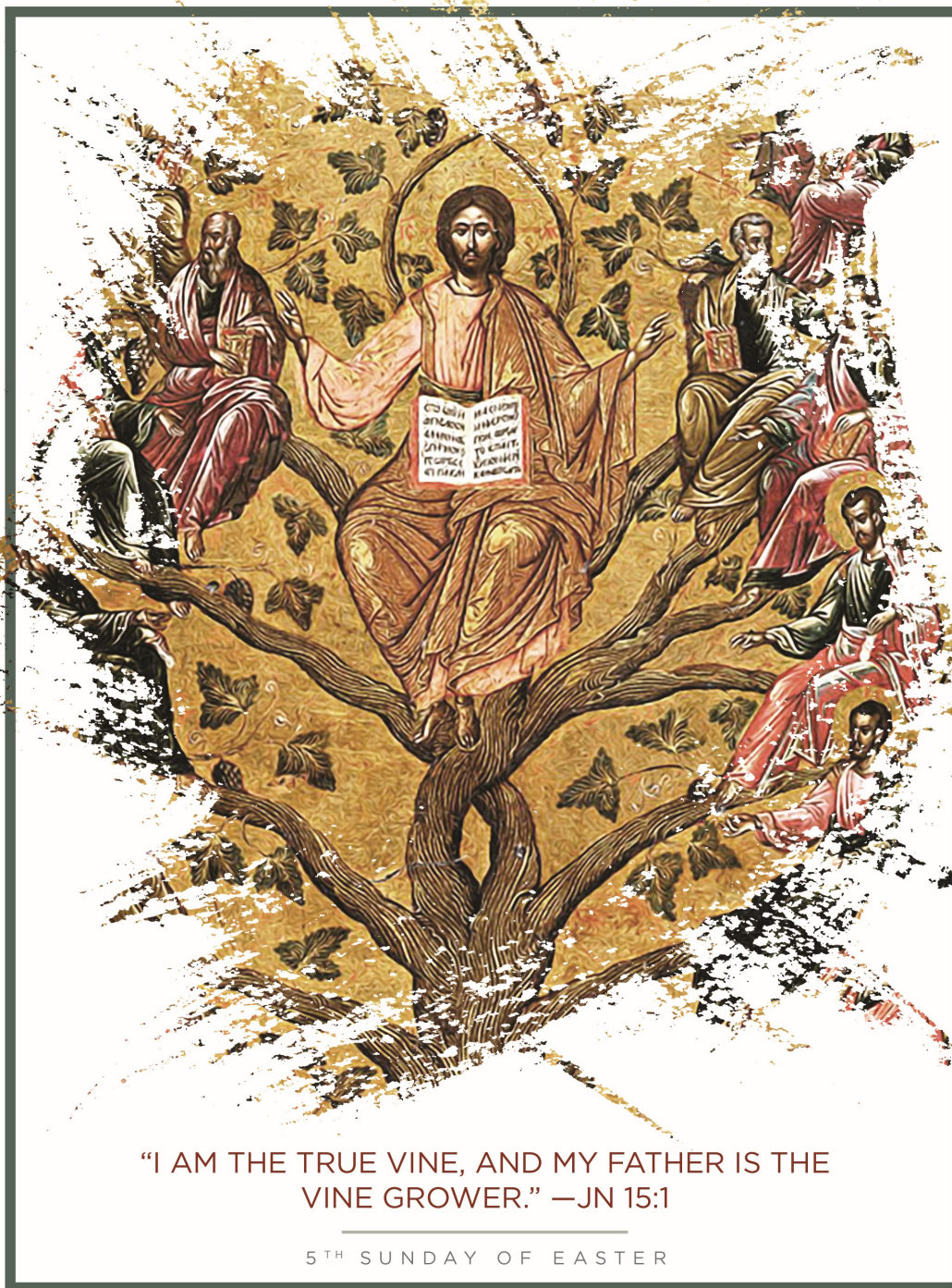

## Stories of Faith: Church Witnesses Then & Now

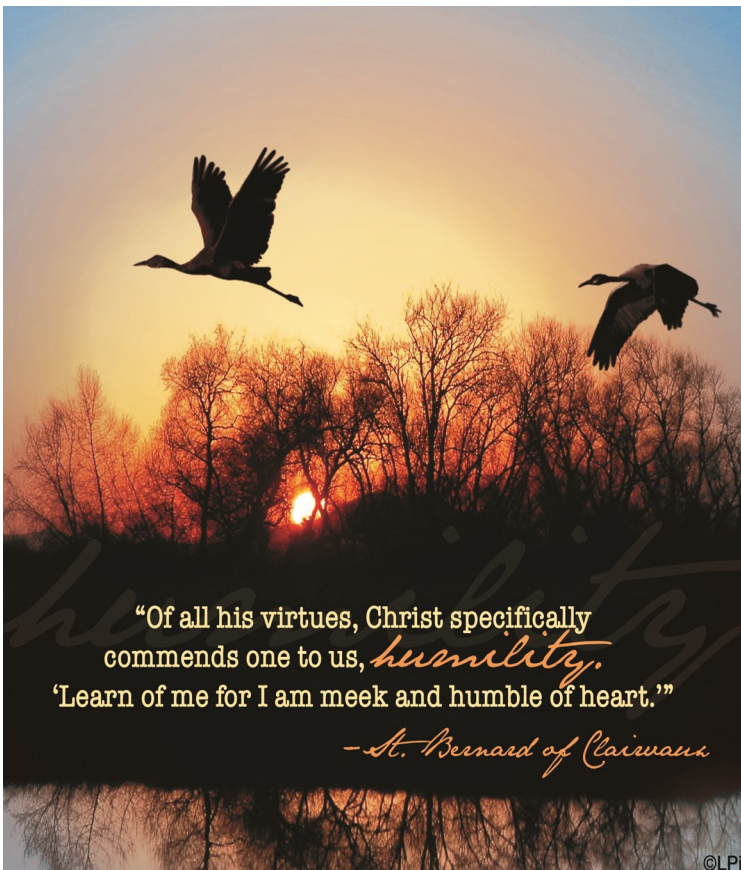
