Deborah (Deb) R. Felice is an attorney who practiced family law in Tulsa for three years before then devoting most of her career to law school administration and law student counseling. In 2012, her accomplishments were recognized nationally when the Association of American Law Schools (AALS) Section on Law Student Services presented her with its annual award in recognition of excellence in the provision of services to law students.

In recent years, Deborah has focused her attention on two specific areas of personal interest: mediation of all types of disputes and service as the Guardian ad Litem in family law matters.

As a peacemaker, Deborah welcomes the challenge of assisting clients in settling their family law and other issues through mediation. As a Guardian ad Litem, she represents the best interests of children by thoroughly investigating the children's life situation, prepares a lengthy summary of findings, and makes recommendations to the Court in family law cases.
