Gratitude in Action: Our Way of Life

"This is my commandment: love one another as I love you. No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends." (John 15:12-13) Jesus laid down His life in the most extreme example of selfless love.

We approach the priest or minister at Mass with deep reverence and great respect to receive the Most Precious Body and Blood of our Lord.

Whether we receive Jesus' Precious Body on our tongue or lovingly receive His Body in the throne of our outstretched hand, we know this is truly Jesus, the Living Presence. We approach to receive, not in a casual or carefree manner, but in a most undistracted and reverent one. We receive this Living Presence as if receiving into our hands a most fragile piece of crystal, fearful of dropping or damaging it in any manner.

*"There are a million reasons to be distracted when we receive Communion. But what an opportunity we miss! Receiving Communion is really entering into communion with Jesus—it's not just an action; it is a key part of a relationship."*¹

Likewise, when we receive Jesus' most Precious Blood so bravely shed in atonement for our sins and offenses, this, too, we receive in a most deliberate and respectful manner. We are not merely taking a sip of water but rather tasting that Living Presence, the Precious Blood of Jesus. We reach out to receive the vessel extended to us and take it to our own lips with great respect and loving gratitude for the sacrifice offered for our eternal salvation.

*"In the Eucharist we truly receive Jesus's Body and Blood into our bodies, and along with that we receive healing and strength for our souls."*²

We are offered *"The Body of Christ"* and *"The Blood of Christ"*, the Living Presence, and to each invitation we respond *"Amen"*, *"I believe!"*
