- 8) Highways matters- consultation on A417 –Council agreed its response in particular, green elements of the proposal received positive comments. Section 1 –Brockworth to Shab Hill in favour- general feeling was positive. Section 2 Proposed green bridge- very much in favour and would applaud efforts to encourage environmental elements. Section 3-Cowley Junction Concerns were raised regarding a continuation of the current "rat run" towards Painswick/Stroud areas that may be

After some discussion, it was felt that Brimpsfield might be more inconvenienced by the removal of the proposed junction and therefore, on balance, it was considered that the junction should remain

However, the Parish Council continues to have concerns that the Cowley junction may be used as a rat run for people looking for a short cut towards Stroud on completion of the project and that traffic calming methods and signage to counter this should be established as part of the scheme.

Alternative 2 – In favour. Repurposing the existing A417 section – fully support Construction – Use of alternative routes through Brimpsfield during the construction stage. The Council has real concerns regarding the safety of pedestrians, cyclists, horse riders and other road users due to increased through traffic during the period of construction and this issue must be addressed before the project starts as part of the planning of the construction process. Any other Comments- The Council would be very interested in any information on financial support for the community to alleviant any negative impacts of the construction project. The Council are supportive of the project as a whole.
