Brief update from the June 20, 2019 Council Meeting

Present: Pam Borgeson, Lisa Clairmont, Audrey McNevin, Kathy Remes, Jeff Stone, Lee-Ann Trigler.

The meeting was called to order and the agenda was accepted as presented; Audrey led devotions.

The May 16th Council Meeting Minutes, May Treasurer & Financial Secretary Reports we unanimously accepted as presented.

There was a brief follow up on Directory & Prayer calls, meetings and cards that were going to take place resulting from the May meeting.

2019 Upcoming Mission Projects

- Summer backpack packaging with school supplies for children in need for Back to School. Kathy is still organizing and will communicate with the congregation on the list of donation needs. She is also reaching out to All Saints and St. John's to see if they want to participate in this program.

- November food packaging event. Jeff & Pam have met with a larger group and hope to have the complete steering committee assembled by mid-July. The goal for 2019 is to package 250,000 meals (we packaged 102,000 meals last year).
- December—gift collection for families in need. *Lisa and Audrey* to coordinate. They will not start to organize around this until end of summer.

Pastoral Transition Discussion

- Parish Life and Lisa met with Padre Tim a few weeks ago to discuss worship and how Parish Life works with the Pastor on worship and related things. Lisa got Tim the materials for the 6/23 service a few weeks early in case he had any questions on the format.
- Padre Tim had suggested some summer events that he was interested in doing and Jeff briefly mentioned them to the Council and said that he forwarded those items to the Parish Life group for their next meeting.
- Jeff reviewed a brief Worship time survey with council to get feedback and the feedback was positive. Jeff mentioned that we would not conduct the survey until Tim was onboard and had a chance to provide his feedback
- A meeting has been set with a few members of JIC and St. John’s along with Padre Tim to discuss potential worship conflicts (Christmas Eve, Holy Week 2020) as well as opportunities between the two congregations (mission projects, etc.). This group is commissioned with the discussion and potential resolution of issues and opportunities and will bring those thoughts back to Parish Life and Council for eventual action/decisions.

Yard Sale

Once again under George & Carol’s leadership the Yard Sale was a big success, bringing in approximately \$1100.00. Pam will follow up with the Porters to determine if they need any help in getting the left over merchandise out of the building.
