3. ADITONAL INFORMATION

The painting is the "male" counterpart to the painting FEMALE produced in August 2003. The sketch of male and female were created at the same time but it took so many years and a continental shift for MALE to finally come alive.

The strength, the power and the passion of the painting is shown in the bright and fiery colors from red to orange to yellow. The simplicity of "the man" is represented in the same style as in the sketch "life is not one straight line" also produced in 2003, exhibited in the Dallas Museum of Arts and which won the 4th place in competition.

The brown fabric is a left over piece of a painfully ended relationship, marking the drastic cultural differences between the Arab world and the west. The dead wood placed over it shall visualize how nature lives and dies – and as a German saying goes – "to let it grow over".
