Rules and Regulations

Every Class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Class specifications, conduct and judging shall be subject in accordance with ASHA and AMHA and guided by USEF rules where applicable. The show committee reserves the right to interpret the show rules and regulations and act as necessary in the best interests of the show. Every entry constitutes an agreement that the person making it shall be subject to all rules and regulations of the Almost Summer Horse Show and the decisions of its committee.

Entries

Entries must be made in writing and signed by the (1) exhibitor, (2) the rider, driver, handler, vaulter or longeur, (3) the trainer, and (4) the coach, if applicable, or by the agent(s) of such person(s) and must be accompanied by funds to cover entry fees and stall fees. In the case of a rider, driver, handler, vaulter or longeur under the age of 18, his/her parent or guardian, or if not available, the trainer, must sign an entry blank on the minor's behalf. Checks to be made payable to Almost Summer Horse Show.

Post Entries

Post entries are any entries made after the advertised closing date of May 18, 2017. Any entry received after the closing date of May 18, 2017 will be considered a post entry and will be accepted, at the discretion of the Horse Show Management, with an additional charge of \$30 per horse, payment in full and a fully completed and signed Entry Blank. **Post entries can only be accepted prior to the starting of the class and upon signature of exhibitor or his/her agent and trainer.**

Personal Checks

Any check refused by the bank for any reason will be assessed a \$30.00 penalty. Then the full obligation, plus the \$30.00 penalty, must be covered by a money order, cashier's check or cash. Additionally, any and all entries for which a refused check is written will forfeit all paybacks. All checks must be pre-printed with the current information (name, address and telephone number).

Office and Exercise Schedules

Schedules for office hours and exercising times will be posted at the Show Secretary's office.

Scheduling

The management of the Almost Summer Horse Show reserves the right to add, split, combine or cancel any classes. Classes with less than five entries may be withdrawn from the program at the discretion of the Horse Show Management. Juvenile, Academy and Equitation classes with four or fewer entries may be combined. Medal classes that do not have the required number of entries to be complete may be canceled.

Feed and Bedding

No bedding is provided. Bedding, hay and grain may be obtained from the Feed Proprietor selling these items at the show. Please make arrangements in advance with the Feed Proprietor. You are responsible for your payment and at no time will the Almost Summer Horse Show Management be responsible for payment.

Health Requirements

All out-of-state horses are to be examined by a licensed veterinarian and found to be free of any infectious or communicable disease, and such information must be properly recorded on a health certificate accompanying each horse. It is recommended that horses be given influenza boosters before arriving at the horse show. For entry into the state of Colorado, a Coggins test is required.



Stalls

Stalls will be assigned by the Barn Manager with preference given to properly completed entries submitted by the May 18, 2017 closing date. Exhibitors will be given preference if they have entries in by the closing date. Horses must be placed in assigned stalls and no change will be permitted without the consent of the Horse Show Management. Exhibitors should order only the actual number of stalls required, and only one stall per entered horse on which fees are paid will be allocated.

Stalls will not be available until 8:00am on Thursday June 1, 2017. Out-of-state horses may be granted early entry (Wednesday May 31) – please contact the Barn Manager for arrangements. There is a \$25 per-day, per-stall fee added for early entry. Exhibitors will be billed for damage to stalls in excess of normal wear and tear. Stall charts will be posted. Any changes of entries after the closing date will be subject to management's approval and subject to a first-come/first-served basis. No first bedding is supplied. Exhibitors, horses and belongings must be off the premises by noon on Monday, June 5, 2017.

Ring Procedure

The show ring will be under the absolute control of the Horse Show Manager. All entries must be ready and waiting to enter the ring promptly. The in-gate must be closed two (2) minutes after the first horse enters the ring. When the gates are closed and the judge has started to work, no exhibitor who is late will be admitted. During the time of the judging, no person will be allowed in the ring except horse show officials, judges, stewards, and when necessary, trainers or attendants of the horses to be judged.

It is a tradition of the competition ring that exhibitors be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed and horses properly presented. The Horse Show Management may at its discretion bar an entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

Condition of Entry and Liability

Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Almost Summer Horse Show Management. Neither the Almost Summer Horse Show, the Horse Show Management nor the Town of Estes Park will be in any case responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it is a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold such bodies harmless for any loss or accident to horse(s), property or equipment that may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise. The Almost Summer Horse Show, the Horse Show Management and the Town of Estes Park will not be responsible or liable for any injury or death in any way by exhibitors, spectators or employees. Neither the Almost Summer Horse Show nor the Town of Estes Park are responsible for personal injury or loss or damage of any personal property by accident, theft, fire, or act of God. All exhibitors enter strictly at their own risk. **WARNING: Under Colorado law, an equine professional is not liable for any injury to or death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to §13.21.119, Colorado Revised Statutes.**

Courtesy and Disputes

The Almost Summer Horse Show reserves the right to eliminate from competition and remove from show grounds without liability or recourse of any kind, any exhibitor(s) or person(s) who show unruly or offensive behavior, engage in illegal activities display disobedience or disrespect to judges, official, exhibitors, volunteers, spectators or any other participants. Such persons shall forfeit all prizes, ribbons and entry fees. No exhibitor shall approach the judge in regards to a decision without first seeking permission of show management. **No disputes will be heard by the Show or Hearing Committees while the show is in sessions. Decisions by the committee shall be final.**



Refunds and Vet-outs

Entries will be accepted through May 18, 2017. Exhibitors canceling their entries after the official date for the closing of entries, without a veterinarian's certificate, shall forfeit all fees. Vet-outs made prior to June 14, 2017 (the start of the show), with a veterinarian's certificate, shall forfeit only the office fee and stall fees. Vet-outs made during the show (June 13, 2017 or later) with a veterinarian's certificate shall forfeit all fees with the exception of entry fees. No refunds will be made during the show. The competition will refund entry fees in the event of cancelation of classes due to severe weather or other emergency.

Welcome to one of Colorado's finest homestead ranches. With roots to the 1870's, MacGregor Ranch remains a showplace of early life among settlers and homesteaders in the early Colorado Territory. Founded in 1873 by Alexander and Clara MacGregor, and left in trust by their granddaughter Muriel MacGregor, the Ranch today serves as a working cattle ranch and a youth education center in the beautiful Black Canyon Creek area of Estes Park.

MacGregor Ranch offers a window into the past for its visitors. Take a step back in time as you come in the front gate. Percheron draft horses and ranch hands work the hay meadow. The main ranch house, now the museum, is warm and inviting - welcoming children's groups and summer visitors. The Black Angus cattle and horses grazing the meadow remind you of simpler times.

The scenic landscape is untouched, as it offers a look back in time to the early homesteading days of Estes Park and the Black Canyon Creek area. The Lumpy Ridge borders the Ranch on the north boundary and offers dramatic views of the Estes valley. The Ranch is a unique living history example of early days in Estes Park.

ROCKY MOUNTAIN SHOWDOWN SECTION

Rocky Mountain Horse Show Association again presents the Rocky Mountain Showdown! Horses who participate can qualify for the Showdown Jackpot held at Colorado Fall Charity Horse Show! Here's how it works: A Rocky Mountain Showdown English Pleasure class and a Rocky Mountain Showdown Western Pleasure class will be offered at many 2017 horse shows recognized by RMHSA, including Colorado Classic, Almost Summer, Denver Queen City, Continental Divide and Fall Charity. In order to qualify for the Showdown Jackpot held at the 2017 Colorado Fall Charity Horse Show, a horse must be entered, shown and judged in at least two of the classes offered at shows during the 2017 show season. Owners and riders must be current members of RMHSA. Horses may show in these classes without showing in the finals. Additional shows may offer qualifying classes and this will be noted in their premium books. These classes will be judged under local rules, and therefore, horses showing in these classes will not be required to pay the Federation Drug Fee (unless they are also showing in Federation-recognized classes as well). Class finals, which will be held at Colorado Fall Charity, will offer Jackpot paybacks!

Local rules. As defined in the Federation Rule Book, all classes in this section shall be defined as Exhibition Classes, but will be judged and tied. If entries warrant, classes will be divided into 18 & Over and 17 & Under classes.

Academy Division

Riders in this division must be riding a horse who earns his living as a school horse. Riders may not enter any other division at this show. Shirts: long sleeved, button down shirts with a tie are required. Vests or sweaters (in cooler weather) worn over the shirt and tie are optional. Pants: to consist of jodhpurs, breeches or black pants in good condition. Blue jeans are acceptable ONLY in Western classes. Footwear: to consist of paddock, jodhpur, hunt or cowboy boots. HELMETS ARE REQUIRED IN ALL ACADEMY CLASSES FOR RIDERS 17 AND UNDER AND ARE HIGHLY RECOMMENDED FOR ADULT RIDERS AS WELL.

The rider will be judged on basic equitation skills and his/her ability to control the horse. Once a rider has shown in a Walk/Trot/Canter class at any recognized or non-recognized show, he/she is no longer eligible to show in the Walk/Trot Division. No extended gaits or backing will be asked for in either Academy division.
