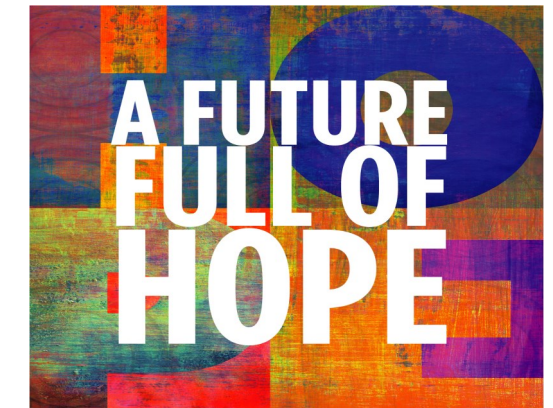
**Happy

A NEW ARCHBISHOP

Paul D. Archbishop Etienne (pronounced "AY-chin") of Anchorage, Alaska, has been appointed by Pope Francis as coadjutor (a bishop who assists another bishop, with the right of succession) of the Archdiocese of Seattle. He has served the church for nearly 27 years as a priest and 10 years as a bishop. Archbishop Etienne's appointment was announced by the Papal Nuncio to the United States on April 29. A "Rite of Reception" Mass will be celebrated June 7, at St. James Cathedral in Seattle. Archbishop J. Peter Sartain stated that a series of spinal issues prompted him to request that Pope Francis appoint a coadjutor archbishop, "with a view toward retiring much sooner than typical, because of my health." As coadjutor, Archbishop Etienne will automatically become the head of the archdiocese when Archbishop Sartain steps down the date for which has yet to be determined.

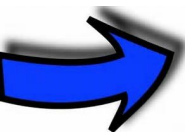


ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL FOR 2019

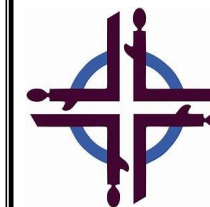
PENTECOST PICNIC
