A local law repealing Local Law #3 of the year 1984 which provides alternative veteran's exemptions shall not be granted pursuant to Real Property Tax Law Section ~~458-a~~ 458-a and reducing the maximum exemption allowable to \$6,000, \$4,000 and \$20,000 for services during a designated period of war, services in a combat zone and for disability respective

SECTION 1 - LEGISLATIVE INTENT

It is the legislative intent of the within Local Law to repeal Local Law #3 of the year 1984 for the Town of Cohocton, New York. Local Law #3 of the year 1984 provided that alternative veteran's exemptions authorized by Real Property Tax Law §458-a would not be allowed. By repealing Local Law #3 of the year 1984, alternative veteran's exemptions would now be allowed.

It is the further legislative intent of the within Local Law to exercise the option relative to limitations of the exemption of taxation as provided in Real Property Tax Law §458-a(2)(d)(ii) so as to permit the maximum exemption allowable in Real Property Tax Law §458-a(2), paragraphs "a", "b", and "c" to be limited to \$6,000, \$4,000 and \$20,000 respectively.

SECTION 2 - REPEAL OF LOCAL LAW #3 OF THE YEAR 1984

Local Law #3 of the year 1984 be and the same hereby is repealed.

SECTION 3 - ELECTION OF LIMITATIONS REDUCING THE MAXIMUM EXEMPTION

The maximum exemption allowable in paragraphs "a", "b", and "c" of sub-division 2 of the Real Property Tax Law §458-a be and the same hereby are established at \$6,000, \$4,000 and \$20,000 respectively.

SECTION 4 - EFFECTIVE DATE

The within Local Law shall be effective immediately upon passage subject to Real Property Tax Law §458-a(4).
