News from Burundi

"We have an outreach in a remote village of the Batwa or "Pygmy people" as some would call them. The Batwa tribe is a marginalized community of Burundi and constitutes one percent of the population of Burundi.

Aline is among those who received the Soup Mix. She insisted that the team come to see where she lives. Aline is a young widow who just lost her husband a year ago, leaving behind a two year old son. Aline lives with her mother-in-law in an uncompleted family hut. Just after a few minutes in prayer both Aline and her mother-in-law burst inconsolably into tears. They are broken and desperate for help. In my ears from the aging mother-in-law I heard "Imana ibahezagire cane kuza kuturemesha" which literally means "God bless you for comforting us" "
