# Show Me the Money <u>Rules</u> (2019) Producers

Show Me the Money will be produced by Rocky Top Arena, Rock N Horse Productions and PBHA (no points), and co-sanctioning will be established before the race. The below rules apply to this additional event.

Co-sanction "eye-fees" will be collected from those riders desiring co-sanction points or qualifiers.

## **Race Entries**

2 Ways to enter:

1.) Enter by mail – stalls must be paid for at time of reservation. No refunds for stalls. Print out the entry on line and mail to PBHA PO Box 939 Rochester, WA. 98579

Pre-Entries must be paid in full and postmarked by Oct 15th, 2019. Checks postdated without race producer approval will not be accepted.

2. Enter on line

If entering on line at pacificbarrelhorse.com and you draw out before Tuesday Oct. 23<sup>rd</sup> you will not be penalized. If you draw out after Oct 23<sup>rd</sup> and do not have a medical or Vet slip you will owe \$10 draw out fee and will not be able to ride with us again until it is paid.

Late entries will be charged a one-time \$10 late fee.

## Draw outs

Refund minus office fee for draw out up till Saturday before the race if prepaid. Draw outs after this date will be for only visible injuries or sickness of horse or rider. Special situations maybe considered by the race producer. Their decision is final. Office staff needs to be notified by either a text or email before start of the Race Saturday.

Vet/ Medical Slip needs to be presented to office staff within 5 days after the race has been completed on the Vet's/Doctor's business letterhead.

Stalls/ Pens that are reserved may be sold by the buyer (not through the office) **No Stall/ Pen refunds after the pre entry deadline.** 

All refunds will be mailed 2 weeks after the race. (This allows checks to be processed through the bank account.)

# LATE ENTRIES AT RACE

Late entries will be taken at the race through the 50 rake.

## **Dress Code**

Dress code is encouraged but not required Dress code is a long sleeve western shirt and Hat or Helmet

## **Race Categories**

**Open 5D:** \$55 entry fee each day. This class is open to any rider.

**Youth 5D**: \$20 entry fee each day. This class is open to all persons 17 years of age or younger on January 1, 2019. Riders entered in youth cannot enter the PEEWEE class

<u>Senior 5D</u>: \$20 entry fee each day. A competitor may roll their Open time into the senior class at any time on or after their 45<sup>th</sup> Birthday.

**Novice Class**: \$20 entry fee each day. The Class will be 4 divisions, ½ second between divisions. The first medals division will start 2.5 seconds slower than the winning Open race 1D time. A time ran that is faster than 2.5 seconds from the winning Open 1D time will receive a no-time. Badge riders must run in the class, times cannot be rolled into the Badge class.

<u>PeeWee 5D</u>: \$10 entry fee each day (arena fee included). This class is open to all persons 10 years and under as of Jan 1<sup>st</sup> 2019

### Proof of age may be requested for PeeWee, Youth and Senior Classes

**Office Charge:** A \$20 office charge for weekend or \$10 per day. Additional horse fee of \$5 a day per horse for multiple horses.

#### <u>Time Runs</u>:

\$5 per run pay at gate 1 minute maximum. Time runs begin at 8AM. 1<sup>st</sup> come no reservations.

#### **Payouts**

70% of entry fee payout, 1 place per 20 riders: OPEN 5D - \$1,500 added, Youth 5D - no added, Senior 5D no added, Badge Class 4D no added.

#### **5D Division percentages**

1D - 26% 2D - 23%

3D - 20% 4D - 17%

5D - 14%

## Race Rules

A barrel down will result in a no-time.

An off-course run will receive a no-time. Any dismount, voluntary or un-voluntary while on course will result in a no-time.

The decision to award a time, or to post a no-time rests with an appointed "Arena Official" or show management. The ruling will be final.

Re-runs may be granted for timer or show equipment failure, or interference as determined by the "Arena Official".

If a no-time situation occurs before the above-mentioned re-run reasons, the no-time will stand.

No re-runs will be granted for rider or equipment failure.

Re-runs can be ran immediately, or if the rider chooses, they may run just after a "big" rake. We will then do a quick clean-up rake and get back to our run order.

Poor sportsmanship or abuse of a horse will not be tolerated. Offenders may be warned, they may be asked to leave the facility at the discretion of show management and will forfeit all entries, stall, office and other fees paid.

# **Issues Not Covered**

Any situation arising not covered by these rules or BRN4D rules will be addressed individually by the Arena Official and show management. The ruling will be final.

## Awards

<u>Riders must be present to receive their awards. If they are unable to attend the</u> <u>award ceremony they may designate a person to pick up their awards. They must</u> <u>fill out a form at the office.</u>

## **Additional Information and Arena Rules**

- 1. Farm equipment and equipment storage areas are off limits to all.
- 2. Tying over night and self penning is not allowed at Rocky Top
- **3.** Unnecessary roughness will not be allowed.
- 4. Rider has 60 seconds to enter the arena once your name has been called.
- **5.** A Horse that is out of control or a danger to others may be asked to leave with no refunds.
